

This is Mark Brown. I am a resident of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea. I am writing to apply for the position as the LBTS representative to the Hillsboro Inlet District. I have extensive experience in the fields which fall under the jurisdiction of the Hillsboro Inlet Committee, including dredging, navigational aids, beach nourishment and beach erosion control. I believe I am well-qualified for the position and that I can do a good job representing the interests of LBTS and its residents on the committee. I would greatly appreciate your consideration of my application for this job.

I worked for nearly 18 years as the chief of staff and legislative assistant to Congressman William Hughes of New Jersey. He represented a large coastal district similar to that of South Florida, where the beaches, inlets and waterways were the lifeblood of the tourist economy. One of my principal areas of responsibility as Congressman Hughes' staff assistant was shore protection. I was responsible for drafting legislation, writing testimony and helping secure approval of funding for numerous projects to maintain and protect the many miles of beaches and inland waterways in New Jersey.

I worked closely with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, the congressional authorizing and appropriations committees, local units of government and environmental organizations to design and implement comprehensive, environmentally sound beach erosion control and navigation projects. These projects focused on all aspects of shore protection,

including keeping the inlets navigable, proper disposal of contaminated dredge spoils, proper marking of the channels, beach nourishment, construction of jetties or other structures where necessary to naturally replenish the sand on the beaches, and non-structural alternatives to hold down costs and avoid damage to reefs, fisheries and other environmental resources. In 1991, I was honored by the City of Cape May, New Jersey for my efforts to help win approval of a comprehensive navigation and beach restoration project to protect the community and the nearby U.S. Coast Guard base from damaging flooding and beach erosion.

My experience from Congress is applicable to the Hillsboro Inlet District. I understand the commercial importance of maintaining the navigability of the Hillsboro Inlet, the cost constraints, environmental concerns, and the process of working with the local, state and federal governments to fulfill the mission of the Hillsboro Inlet Commission. I believe I would be an asset to both the commission and the town if I am appointed to serve on the committee.
