Subject: Monthly Report to Commission – January 2011

PERSONNEL CHANGES:

No personnel transfer(s) this month.

EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Charlie Shift & Support Personnel

During the last six weeks of 2010, the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District was faced with an unprecedented hardship regarding personnel shortages due to several issues beyond the control of district staff.

Sergeant Tom Palmer, tasked with the district's scheduling responsibilities, realized the magnitude of the issue at hand, especially with the upcoming holiday season, and presented the concern to district staff. Deputies assigned to Charlie Shift and support unit personnel volunteered to adjust their schedules in order to minimize the financial impact to the limited district overtime budget. Furthermore, this sacrifice was made to ensure the safe deployment of personnel on each shift and ensure the residents and visitors of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea receive the superior service they are accustomed to without a perceived reduction in patrol staffing.

Despite recent instances of layoffs and pending reductions to pensions and benefits, everyone partook in this initiative without any complaints or concerns. As a result of their selfless sacrifice, a total of 320 personnel man hours were adjusted and worked by Charlie Shift and support unit personnel. This schedule adjustment resulted in a substantial overtime cost saving. Without their contributions, the LBTS district would have depleted their allotted overtime funding and suffered a critical reduction in future staffing.

This display of teamwork and dedication to the residents we serve reflects an exemplary standard in service, integrity and dedication to duty by the men and women of the Broward Sheriff's Office Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. The Bravo Shift sergeant oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. The Bravo Shift sergeant handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. The Bravo Shift sergeant oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Watch Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Watch Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. The Bravo Shift sergeant oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. The Bravo Shift sergeant oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. The Bravo Shift sergeant continues to manage this program. A statistical summary listing COP activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. The Bravo Shift sergeant is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of five (5) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Five (5) fugitives were apprehended and arrested.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) persons legally classified as sex offenders currently residing within Town limits. These offenders are routinely contacted

by BSO to ensure their continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Deputy Charles Pickell administers this program.

- **Segway Human Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of five and a half (5.5) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of eight (8) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of fifty one (51) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant each year on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Tom Palmer is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure upgrades to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Boards:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

SPECIAL EVENTS: These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

Jazz by the Square: The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor the "Jazz by the Square". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Music by the Sea: Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:

On January 4, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to an aggravated assault on Bougainvillea Drive in which a long time friend of the resident became involved in an argument and lit the bathroom shower curtain on fire. The suspect also armed herself with a knife and attacked the resident. The suspect was apprehended by deputies after she fled the scene. LBTS VFD and the State Fire Marshal responded to assist with the arson investigation.

On January 5, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to a burglary in progress at the Ocean Medical Center. Upon arrival, deputies discovered that a first floor window had been forced open allowing the suspects to gain entry. Based on a witness description, the suspects were apprehended while trying to leave the Town. Investigation revealed that the suspects have an extensive history for burglary and theft of narcotics.

On January 6, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to an accidental injury at the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea Beach Resort. A hotel guest had leaned against the second floor balcony railing which subsequently collapsed, resulting in a fall onto the parking lot below. The victim sustained minor injuries. Preliminary investigation revealed that the bolts had broken free causing its failure. The investigation was turned over to Broward County Building Department and LBTS Code Enforcement.

On January 26, 2011, LBTS deputies received information that several subjects suspect would be delivering heroin to a location in the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Several suspects were arrested for Delivery of a Controlled Substance. The vehicle used in the crime was confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture.
