**PERSONNEL CHANGES:**

Sergeant Gary Brown was transferred to the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district on December 18, 2010, filling the vacancy created by Sergeant Doug Brown's recent retirement.

**EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Sergeant Peter LaGana & Deputy Roberta Ditullio**

On December 6, 2010 LBTS deputies received an alarm call at T & R Tackle, located on Commercial Boulevard. Upon arrival, deputies discovered that someone had forcibly broken onto the business and stolen several items.

Sergeant LaGana quickly responded to the scene and immediately took charge of the investigation. Having knowledge of a recent bait and tackle store burglary trend throughout Palm Beach and Broward counties, and believing the suspects would soon strike again; Sergeant LaGana broadcast a "Be-On-The-Lookout" bulletin across the countywide radio.

Minutes after the radio broadcast, Pompano Beach Deputy Ditullio began to patrol the bait and tackle shops in her area. Almost immediately, she received a call about a break-in at Atlantic Bait & Tackle on Atlantic Boulevard. Although the suspects fled prior to her arrival, she was able to ascertain the suspect vehicle description through her investigation. She then began a systemic search of the area, believing that the suspects were hiding out until deputies left the area so they could make their getaway. Deputy Ditullio was able to locate the suspect vehicle some time later that night. The vehicle was stopped, and the suspects were taken into custody. All stolen property was recovered from the vehicle. Deputy Ditullio made sure that Sergeant LaGana was

notified of the arrest, and also helped the responding detectives coordinate the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea investigation.

As a result of their keen observation skills and excellent tactical procedures, their teamwork and cooperation led to the apprehension of these criminals before more businesses were victimized. These actions embody the highest standards of professional law enforcement, and their intra-agency communication serves as a role-model for other districts.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:** These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. The Bravo Shift sergeant oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. The Bravo Shift sergeant handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. The Bravo Shift sergeant oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Watch Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Watch Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. The Bravo Shift sergeant oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. The Bravo Shift sergeant oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. The Bravo Shift sergeant continues to manage this program. A statistical summary listing COP activity is found at the end of this report.

- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. The Bravo Shift sergeant is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of four (4) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Four (4) fugitives were apprehended and arrested.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) persons legally classified as sex offenders currently residing within Town limits. These offenders are routinely contacted by BSO to ensure their continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Deputy Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Human Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of three and a quarter (3.25) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of twenty four (24) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of thirty two and a quarter (32.25) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant each year on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Tom Palmer is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure upgrades to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can

register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.

- **Electronic Message Boards:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

**Jazz by the Square:** The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor the "Jazz by the Square". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Music by the Sea:** Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Kids in Distress Cycling Challenge:** Kids in Distress sponsored a charity bicycle ride along SR A1A on December 5, 2010. A large number of bicyclists rode through Lauderdale-by-the-Sea throughout the day, requiring traffic control. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Menorah Lighting Ceremony:** The Chabad of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea held its annual Menorah Lighting Ceremony on December 5, 2010 at the Beach Pavilion. The event included several public speakers and live music. LBTS district deputies were assigned a directed patrol of this event.

**Christmas-by-the-Sea Parade and Event:** The Chamber of Commerce and the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted their annual Christmas-by-the-Sea Parade & Event on December 8, 2010. The parade along Commercial Boulevard consisted of elected officials, town dignitaries, public safety providers, high school marching bands and several other participating groups. The Christmas tree lighting took place at Anglin Square and included several live music acts and other performers. Four (4) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents. Furthermore, ten (10) deputy sheriffs from other BSO commands participated to ensure the success of this event. This mutual aid participation was at no additional cost to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

**Marie White's Annual "Santa is Coming to Town":** The annual "Santa is Coming to Town" event took place on December 11, 2010 at the Beach Pavilion. Children had the opportunity to take photographs with Santa Claus. LBTS district deputies were assigned a directed patrol of this event.

**New Year's Eve Block Party:** Several downtown area restaurants hosted their annual New Year's Eve Block Party on December 31, 2010 at Anglin Square. Area restaurants catered the event to include live music and other festivities. Seven (7) off-duty BSO detail deputies were

assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents. In addition, LBTS district deputies were assigned a directed patrol of this event due to the large crowd that attended.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:**

On December 6, 2010, LBTS deputies responded to an alarm at a local bait & tackle shop. Upon arrival, deputies discovered that a burglary had taken place. The suspect was arrested later that night with the assistance of deputies from the Pompano Beach district. It appears that the suspect is responsible for burglaries to several bait & tackle shops and dive shops throughout South Florida.

On December 19, 2010, LBTS deputies responded to a medical call to assist LBTS VFD and AMR. A person working on a second floor balcony leaned into a railing, which apparently gave away, causing the subject to fall to the ground. The subject sustained minor injuries. Investigation revealed no criminal conduct.

On December 23, 2010, LBTS deputies received information that a suspect would be delivering crack cocaine to a location in the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The suspect was arrested for Delivery of a Controlled Substance. The vehicle used in the crime was confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture.

Throughout the holiday season, LBTS deputies participated in an operational plan designed to reduce the likelihood of victimization of residents and visitors shopping and dining throughout the town. Use of the message board, Cybervisor, and other media outlets appeared to be extremely effective due to the large number of comments made by citizens regarding the operational plan and increased law enforcement presence. The operation plan succeeded in its goal of educating citizens about crime prevention strategies and creating an overall feeling of security for local residents and visitors. No violent or forcible crimes occurred within the scope of this operational plan.
