Subject: Monthly Report to Commission – September 2011

PERSONNEL CHANGES:

There were no personnel changes for the month of September.

EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Louis Kattou

On September 3, 2011, Deputy Kattou was informed of ongoing narcotics activity at a local motel. Upon responding to the target location, Deputy Kattou began surveillance of the area and developed information which corroborated this report.

After apprehending two suspects, Deputy Kattou was able to establish a rapport with them, which led to a confession and additional critical intelligence related to the trafficking of narcotics within Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

Further investigation revealed that these suspects had extensive criminal histories, and may be involved in other crimes within Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

Due to Deputy Kattou's investigative abilities and interview skills, he was able to successfully close out this investigation and develop significant leads on additional ongoing investigations. Deputy Kattou's continued exceptional performance highlights his dedication to the safety of the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A statistical summary listing COP activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of nine (9) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Nine (9) fugitives were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.

- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There is one (1) person legally classified as sex offender currently residing within Town limits. This offender is routinely contacted by BSO to ensure his continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. The only other sex offender living within Town limits has moved to a different state. Existing municipal ordinances prohibit additional persons classified as a sex offender or predator from residing within Town limits. Corporal Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of four (4) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of twenty eight (28) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of thirty one (31) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Gary Brown is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant each year on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Tom Palmer is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure upgrades to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.

- **Electronic Message Board:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

SPECIAL EVENTS: These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

Jazz on the Square: The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor “Jazz on the Square”. This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Music by the Sea: Athena’s-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Monday Night Football Party: On Monday, September 12, 2011, the Village Grille hosted their annual Monday Night Football party event. The event consisted of food, beverage and live music followed by a caravan of charter buses to Joe Robbie Stadium for the Monday Night Football game between the Miami Dolphins versus the New England Patriots. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies were assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:

On September 2, 2011, as part of an ongoing narcotics trafficking investigation, LBTS deputies executed a search warrant on a location identified as a cocaine distribution point. Two (2) suspects were arrested and charged with trafficking in cocaine and other narcotics related charges. The vehicle used in the crime and US currency was confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture.

On September 22, 2011, LBTS deputies conducted a prostitution sting as part of an ongoing vice/narcotics crackdown. The operation resulted in the arrest of four (4) suspects who solicited an undercover deputy for prostitution. One (1) suspect was also charged with possession of felony narcotics. The vehicle used in the crime and US currency was confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture.

On September 24, 2011, LBTS deputies assisted the U.S. Marshals Service in their efforts to locate and capture a wanted felon who had fled his home state. The fugitive was tracked to a temporary residence in Lauderdale-by-the-Sea, where he was apprehended without further incident. The subject is awaiting extradition to face the original charges.
