Subject: Monthly Report to Commission – November 2011

PERSONNEL CHANGES:

There were no personnel changes for the month of November.

EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Charles Pickell

During the month of October 2011, the LBTS district experienced several conveyance burglaries throughout the town. On October 28, 2011, a victim observed a suspect enter his vehicle and rummage through his belongings. The victim startled the suspect, who fled the scene. The victim was able to provide a physical description of the suspect, along with an important clue; the suspect begged the victim not to call the police as it was his birthday.

Although Deputy Pickell was on his regularly scheduled days off, he maintained contact with the district office to determine if there was any progress in the ongoing investigation of the recent conveyance burglaries. Deputy Pickell was briefed on this particular incident by the reporting deputy. Based on the physical description of the suspect, Deputy Pickell believed that it may be the same suspect he had previously investigated on an unrelated incident approximately one year ago. This suspect had aroused his suspicions, as he had a prior criminal record. Deputy Pickell relayed his suspicions to the district detective to follow up.

It was quickly determined that the suspect's birthday was in fact October 28th. Surveillance of the suspect's residence was established, and he was soon taken into custody. The victim was able to identify the suspect as the man who had broken into his vehicle. The suspect confessed to committing this crime, and is in the process of being charged with several other conveyance burglaries.

Due to Deputy Pickell's investigative abilities and devotion in seeing a case through to a successful conclusion, regardless of his duty status, he was instrumental in capturing this criminal and putting an end to his crime spree. Deputy Pickell's continued exceptional performance highlights his dedication to the safety of the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A statistical summary listing COP activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.

- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of seven (7) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Seven (7) fugitives were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There is one (1) person legally classified as sex offender currently residing within Town limits. This offender is routinely contacted by BSO to ensure his continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. The only other sex offender living within Town limits has moved to a different state. Existing municipal ordinances prohibit additional persons classified as a sex offender or predator from residing within Town limits. Corporal Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of three (3) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of twenty five (25) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of twenty eight (28) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Gary Brown is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant each year on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Tom Palmer is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure upgrades to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.

- **Electronic Message Board:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

SPECIAL EVENTS: These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

Jazz on the Square: The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor "Jazz on the Square". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Music by the Sea: Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Community Church Resource Fair: On November 5, 2011, in partnership with the Community Church, the BSO LBTS district participated in a Resource Fair. Deputies and COP members provided attendees with a variety of crime prevention information. Children and parents also had the opportunity to utilize a fingerprint safety identification kit.

Miami Dolphins Cycle Challenge: On November 5-6, 2011, the Miami Dolphins hosted a charity bicycle ride on State Road A1A, including riding through LBTS. Deputies assisted BSO Regional Traffic Unit deputies in ensuring the safety of participants and motorists.

LBTS Arts & Crafts Show: On November 26, 2011, the LBTS Chamber of Commerce hosted its annual Fall Arts & Crafts Show. The event consisted of exhibitions of various arts and crafts from local artists. BSO LBTS district personnel were utilized in providing crowd and traffic control for the event.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:

On November 10, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to Anglin's Fishing Pier in reference to a possible drowning / suicide attempt. A report was received that a female had jumped off the pier, and may be under water. BSO Aviation and Marine Patrol assets were dispatched to assist in the rescue. The female was recovered with the assistance of VFD. Investigation revealed that she had purposely jumped off the pier as a dare by a group of friends. The subject was arrested and charged with disorderly conduct.

On November 12, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to the scene of a traffic accident involving an overturned vehicle at 4136 N. Ocean Drive. Two subjects were transported to the hospital by AMR due to minor injuries. This crash investigation is still ongoing.

During the week of November 6, 2011, two similar attempted burglaries were reported to BSO LBTS deputies. Both incidents occurred in the south Silver Shores area, and both incidents involved a suspect breaking windows in an apparent attempt to open them. Saturation patrols of the target area were implemented, and no additional incidents were reported. This investigation is still ongoing.

On November 14, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to 1461 South Ocean Boulevard in reference to a burglary and auto theft. The resident advised that when they woke up, they discovered that someone had climbed in through an open window and taken a wallet and car keys. The resident's car was also missing from the parking lot. LBTS deputies received information that the vehicle was located in Deerfield Beach. Forensic evidence was identified, and a suspect was developed. As a result of the investigative leads, two suspects were taken into custody and charged with this incident. All property was recovered and returned to the victim. The suspects were also charged with several other similar crimes that occurred in surrounding municipalities.






