**PERSONNEL CHANGES:**

No personnel transfer(s) this month.

**EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: CSIA Toni Anderson**

Throughout CSIA Anderson's tenure at the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district, she has been responsible for developing investigative leads through her collection of forensic evidence on a number of significant cases that otherwise may have gone unsolved. CSIA Anderson's skills as a Crime Scene Investigative Aide have also resulted in the identification and apprehension of several career criminal offenders on numerous different cases.

In addition to her field work, she also has a number of administrative duties, including records management, criminal case filing, court subpoenas and other administrative tasks. Over the years, she has continuously developed new and innovative ways to streamline and organize these tasks to ensure the district remains in compliance with agency and accreditation standards and that all deadlines are met.

Unfortunately, we were recently notified of her mandated transfer to another command as a result of a pending agency-wide reduction in force.

Regardless of this disappointing news, CSIA Anderson continued to strive for excellence and developed a training program and instruction package for the employee(s) that would assume her duties upon departure. Her dedication to duty and the residents of the community in which she serves, as evidenced by her continued hard work in the face of adversity, speaks volumes of her character, work ethic and dedication to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:** These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Watch Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Watch Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A statistical summary listing COP activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of five (4) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Four (4) fugitives were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.

- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) persons legally classified as sex offenders currently residing within Town limits. These offenders are routinely contacted by BSO to ensure their continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Corporal Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Human Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of one (1) hour this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of four (4) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of eighty six (86) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant each year on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Tom Palmer is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure upgrades to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Boards:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

**Jazz by the Square:** The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor the "Jazz by the Square". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Music by the Sea:** Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**A1A Marathon:** On February 20, 2001, Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted a portion of the A1A Marathon charity event. Numerous off-duty detail deputies were assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Taste of the Beach:** On February 23, 2011, the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea Chamber of Commerce hosted its annual Taste of the Beach Event. The event festivities consisted of live entertainment, food from various town and surrounding restaurants, beverages and numerous auctions. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies were assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:**

On February 7, 2011, the victim reported that three subjects robbed him and his father of their wallets after striking the father in the head while they were standing at the Datura Avenue beach portal. The victim also claims that the suspects fired a shot from a small handgun. BSO Crime Scene and Criminal Investigations Division detectives responded to assume the investigation and follow-up on some conflicting information received. The investigation is still active.

On February 9, 2011, Corporal Charles Pickell was operating the electronic ELSAG License Plate Reader (LPR) at the 4300 block of N. Ocean Drive when he identified an stolen vehicle traveling through town. A traffic stop was conducted and the suspect was arrested without further incident.

On February 18, 2011, a female bicyclist was riding her bicycle in the area of Hibiscus and SR A1A when she was involved in a crash with a vehicle that had turned in front of her. She was transported to Broward General Hospital and treated for serious injuries. BSO Traffic Homicide Investigations is monitoring her condition for any progress or signs of deterioration. The investigation is still active.

On February 28, 2011 LBTS deputies received information of a suspicious incident involving several vehicles in the Silver Shores area. Upon subsequent investigation, deputies realized that one of the vehicles they located had been stolen from a town resident. Deputies were able to track down the suspects and subsequently arrested them with assistance provided by several witnesses. An subsequent search of the suspects' residence revealed additional stolen property.
