FY2011 DESIGNATED HIGH PRIORITY ITEM

SUBJECT TITLE: 2011 International Coastal Clean Up, September 17, 2011

EXPLANATION: The annual International Coastal Cleanup is coordinated by Broward County's Environmental and Growth Management Department. The cleanup is scheduled for September 17, 2011 from 9:00am till 12pm. They are requesting that the Town allow them to set up a site at the end of Commercial Boulevard on the north side of the Pier. The volunteers will be collecting trash from the beach and disposing of it the setup/cleanup site. In light of last year's 73 volunteers the County is asking (Exhibit 1) for 73 parking permits for the A-1-A parking lot for this event during the hours of 8:00 am and 1:00 pm. Finally, they are asking that we contact and suspend beach raking for that day.

Last year the volunteers removed 428 lbs. of trash from the Town's beach. One of the objectives of the event is to make an impact on the lives of the volunteers, many of whom are young, and to give them that great feeling of success.

RECOMMENDATION:

We recommend Commission approval for the Town's participation in the September 17, 2011 International Coastal Cleanup Event from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm by arranging the following:

1. Designating a staging site at the Pavilion.
2. Providing 70 parking permits for the volunteers to park in the A-1-A parking between the hours of 8:00 am and 1:00 pm.
3. Suspending beach raking on September 17, 2011.
4. Providing a dumpster for the collected trash (Choice provides at no cost to the Town).
5. Installing a banner sign at the pavilion (2x5) announcing the event.

It is time again for the annual International Coastal Cleanup. I would like to thank the Town of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea for their participation in the past. Please accept this letter as an invitation to continue to help us make this event a success. *If this event requires Town Commission approval, we would like to request this be placed on an upcoming agenda prior to the Town Commission going on summer recess.* In 2010, the Coastal Cleanup brought out 73 volunteers who collected 428 lbs of trash from the Town's beach; countywide, over 1,600 people volunteered to participate.

As we have in the past, we would like to set up a cleanup site at the end of E. Commercial Blvd, just north of Anglin's Pier. The volunteers will be bringing back bags of trash they have collected to this location and I would like to coordinate the specifics of the trash disposal. Please contact me with any comments or directions. Some sites have arranged for an additional dumpster in the past as well.

We are asking for the same parking permit for the volunteers to allow them to park at the "Bougainville Drive Parking Lot" for no charge on the morning of the cleanup. This has been a great way that your Town has helped reward the volunteers for their efforts. Attached is a copy of the pass. If this is acceptable, please have the appropriate person sign the pass and fax it back along with the additional information sheet to 954-519-1493 and we will see that each of the volunteers has a parking pass.

If possible, and you would be willing, this would be a great day to suspend beach raking/cleaning. We are trying to have this event make an impact on the lives of the volunteers, many of whom are young, and they have a great feeling of success seeing the beach before and after.
