**PERSONNEL CHANGES:**

No personnel transfer(s) this month.

**EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Eric Weiner, Deputy Manny Alvarez-Jacinto & Deputy Craig Jacobson**

On April 12, 2011 Deputy Jacobson was flagged down and by a woman screaming for help. He immediately learned that a robbery had just occurred. Without hesitation, he ascertained the description of the suspects, the vehicle they were using, and their direction of travel. He subsequently broadcasted an alert bulletin over the radio to other deputies.

Deputies Alvarez and Weiner heard the alert bulletin and began searching the area where they believed the suspects would likely flee to. Their deduction paid off, as the suspect vehicle was located. A felony stop was conducted and all three suspects were taken into custody. The property taken in the robbery was located inside the vehicle and recovered. Subsequent investigation revealed that these suspects are likely responsible for several other robberies that occurred throughout the local beach areas.

Due to their keen observations, dedication to duty, and teamwork in handling this incident, the deputies were able to capture three active felons, putting a well needed end to their criminal spree. Their phenomenal response to this serious crime highlights their dedication to the safety of the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:** These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Watch Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Watch Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A statistical summary listing COP activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of eight (8) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Eight (8) fugitive(s) were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.

- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) persons legally classified as sex offenders currently residing within Town limits. These offenders are routinely contacted by BSO to ensure their continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Corporal Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Human Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of three and a half (3.5) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of twenty-five (25) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of seventy two and a quarter (72.25) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant each year on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Tom Palmer is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure upgrades to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Boards:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

**Jazz on the Circle:** The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor the "Jazz on the Circle". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Music by the Sea:** Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Easter by the Sea:** The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted their annual Easter Egg Hunt Event at Jarvis Hall on April 23, 2011. This event consisted of an Easter Egg Hunt for all children in attendance, an Easter Bunny Bonnet Contest and the consumption of juice and cookies by participants and guests. BSO conducted a directed patrol of the event.

**Easter Sunrise Service:** The Community Presbyterian Church of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea hosted their Easter Sunrise Service at the Beach Pavilion on April 24, 2011. BSO conducted a directed patrol of the event.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:**

On April 12, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to N. Ocean Drive in reference to a robbery that had just occurred. Three suspects had robbed a tourist and fled in a vehicle. LBTS deputies immediately canvassed the area for the suspects and were able to locate them. All suspects were arrested. The victim's stolen property was recovered in the vehicle.

On April 17, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to Sea Grape Drive to investigate a sexual battery. A female who was attending a party consumed excessive quantities of alcohol to the point of falling asleep. She was awakened by a male having intercourse with her. When the female realized that the subject was not her boyfriend, and only an acquaintance, she screamed and the male subject left the residence. BSO Criminal Investigations Division responded, and the investigation is currently active.

On April 22, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to El Mar Drive in regards to a burglary conveyance. The victim was able to provide a good description of the suspect. Deputies searched the area, and located the suspect a short distance away. The suspect was arrested, and the victim's stolen property was recovered.

On April 23, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to Thomas Way in regards to a burglary conveyance. Deputies observed the suspect walking away from the scene and took her into custody.

On April 24, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to Palm Avenue in regards to a bale of marijuana that had washed ashore, presumably a part of a maritime narcotics trafficking excursion. The marijuana was secured as evidence. BSO Strategic Investigations Division and US Drug Enforcement Agency are assisting with the investigation.

On April 30, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to Cypress Creek Drive in regards to a purse snatching robbery. Investigation revealed that the victim had gone to the Isles Casino and won some money. The suspect apparently followed her home, pushed the victim after she had gotten out of her car, and took the purse. BSO Criminal Investigations Division responded, and the investigation is currently active.
