FY2011 DESIGNATED HIGH PRIORITY ITEM

SUBJECT TITLE: Charges for filming in Town

EXPLANATION: When a film is being taken there is extra work for Town staff: permitting, trash cleaning, road closures, parking, etc. I feel these extra charges should be recovered from the recipient of the location of the filming. I feel the Town is entitled to the extra costs incurred in staging the event.

RECOMMENDATION:

Film permits in the future should reflect the requirement that the Town's expenses will be paid by the owner of the location where the filming takes place.

EXHIBITS: Request that Town staff calls Fort Lauderdale or another municipality to determine if they make a charge whenever film crews cause extra work during the course of the shooting of the film.

The City has no film permit fee, nor does it have an application fee. This issue was discussed with the film commission several years ago and they wanted to foster film and photography in the county, so they frowned upon the city implementing a film/taping fee.

The city does take impact fees where it can and we have an expense such as:

Parking fees
Life guards, when shooting on beach
Business interruption charges - if closing pier, what is the lost revenue
Police special detail
Building permits, where applicable

The city has put the burden of expenses on the party that makes application to the film commission.

Good Afternoon June -

My name is Grace Hall and I am the Film Liaison here at the Town of Davie.

Our Town works very closely with the Greater Fort Lauderdale/Broward Film Commission to process permits for Film/TV Commercial and Still Photography. The only time we actually charge a fee is either when an off duty Police Officer is needed on site for security or traffic reasons, or if the Production Company requests the use of a Town facility and we need to close the specific location to the public. We also charge for electrical permits when the Production Company has generators on site for a shoot that exceed 10KW. The Production Company is the party that is responsible for the payment to the Municipality for these types of costs.

If you are preparing a survey with this information, I would love to get a copy of what you compile as a result of these questions. Thank you and please feel free to contact me directly should you have any additional questions.
