PERSONNEL CHANGES:

On May 7, 2011, Detective Kim Pullease was transferred to the BSO Criminal Investigations Division, Special Victims Unit.

On May 7, 2011, Deputy Craig Bachan was transferred into the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District, filling the vacancy created by Detective Pullease's recent transfer.

On May 21, 2011, Deputy Joseph Duncan was transferred at his request to the BSO Court Services Division. His position is currently vacant until a replacement deputy is selected from the list of available candidates.

On May 31, 2011, Deputy Scott Williams retired from the Broward Sheriff's Office after 32 years of law enforcement service to the community. His position is currently vacant until a replacement deputy is selected from the list of available candidates.

EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Eric Weiner and Deputy Manny Alvarez-Jacinto

Deputy Weiner and Deputy Alvarez-Jacinto were assigned to investigate a series of burglaries occurring in the area adjacent to the City of Ft. Lauderdale. Deputies Weiner and Alvarez-Jacinto diligently set up liaison with their counterparts at the Ft. Lauderdale Police Department and established an operational plan incorporating various investigative techniques to identify and apprehend the person(s) responsible for these crimes.

While conducting surveillance of the target area, they observed a subject who fit the general description of a suspicious person seen around the location of several of the reported burglary incidents. Upon contacting him, he was evasive and lied about his identity. Not satisfied with a making a simple arrest, they continued to investigate, and learned that the subject had an extensive criminal record, including two counts of murder in the first degree, and multiple

burglary and theft charges. Taking the investigation even further, they were able to identify and locate an outstanding no bond arrest warrant for the subject that another jurisdiction inadvertently omitted from entry into the statewide criminal information computer system. Deputy Weiner contacted the BSO Main Jail and made sure the subject was charged with the no bond warrant before he could post a bond and be released from jail.

Due to their keen observations, dedication to duty, and tenacity in conducting criminal investigations, Deputies Weiner and Alvarez-Jacinto were able to capture this fugitive and burglary suspect, putting an end to this burglary trend. Their continued exceptional performance highlights their dedication to the safety of the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Watch Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Watch Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A statistical summary listing COP activity is found at the end of this report.

- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of two (2) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Two (2) fugitive(s) were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) persons legally classified as sex offenders currently residing within Town limits. These offenders are routinely contacted by BSO to ensure their continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Corporal Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Human Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of three and a half (3.5) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of eighty-two (82) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of eighty five and a half (85.5) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant each year on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Tom Palmer is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure upgrades to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information,

upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.

- **Electronic Message Board:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

SPECIAL EVENTS: These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

Jazz on the Circle: The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor the "Jazz on the Circle". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Music by the Sea: Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Memorial Day Beach Bash: The Aruba Beach Café sponsored its annual Memorial Day Beach Bash Event on May 30, 2011. The event festivities consisted of a food buffet, pig roast, live music, dancing and promotional giveaways. Three (3) off-duty BSO detail deputies were assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents. Additionally, three (3) deputies from other BSO divisions assisted with the event due to the large crowds. This mutual aid participation was at no additional cost to LBTS residents.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:

On May 5, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to Walgreen's in reference to a report of a robbery that had just occurred. The suspect stole jewelry and fought with employees as they attempted to stop the suspect. LBTS deputies immediately canvassed the area, and were able to locate and arrest the suspect. The stolen property was recovered.

On May 8, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to Sea Grape Drive in reference to a single vehicle crash where the driver had fled the scene. Upon arrival, deputies observed that a black Dodge Charger had struck a utility pole and tree, causing in excess of \$2,500 dollars in damage to town property. Based on their investigation, deputies were able to identify and locate the owner of the vehicle.

On May 10, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to Commercial Boulevard in reference to a physical altercation involving a female and her ex-boyfriend. Upon the deputies arrival, the suspect fled into the Silver Shores neighborhood. A perimeter was established, and an attempt to locate the suspect was made, utilizing the assistance of BSO Aviation and K-9, as well as assistance from other BSO districts. The suspect was not located, and is believed to have driven away in a vehicle. An arrest warrant has been obtained for the known suspect, and the investigation is currently active.

On May 17, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to Ocean Drive to assist LBTS VFD with a structure fire on the ninth floor of the condominium building. BSO assisted VFD with the evacuation of the building and conducted traffic control. The fire appears to be accidental.

On May 23, 2011, LBTS deputies observed a suspect openly masturbating in front of several people at the Datura area of the beach. When confronted, the suspect attempted to evade capture, but was subsequently apprehended and arrested.

On May 26, 2011, LBTS deputies received information that a suspect would be delivering crack cocaine to a location in the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The suspect was arrested for Delivery of a Controlled Substance. The vehicle used in the crime and US currency was confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture.

On May 30, 2011, LBTS deputies were flagged down in Anglin Square and advised of a robbery that had just occurred. Several suspects robbed a tourist and fled the area in a vehicle. LBTS deputies immediately canvassed the area, and were able to locate and arrest one of the suspects. This investigation is currently active.


