**Subject: Monthly Report to Commission – June 2011**

**PERSONNEL CHANGES:**

On June 4, 2011, Deputy Mark Rider was transferred into the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District, filling an existing vacancy created by a previous retirement.

**EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Eric Weiner and Deputy Craig Jacobson**

On Memorial Day, Deputy Jacobson arrested a female for her role in the theft of money from a local business. The subject had an extensive criminal record. The subject listed her home address as another city, and claimed that this was the first time she had visited Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

Several days later, while conducting targeted surveillance of a location linked to ongoing criminal activity, Deputy Weiner observed the same female suspect exit the target location. Deputy Weiner conducted an in depth investigation, and discovered that this subject may reside within the town. While Deputy Weiner was sharing this information at roll call briefing, Deputy Jacobson received a report of a female subject who had just stolen various merchandise from a local business. Based on the description, Deputy Jacobson believed it to be their target, and both he and Deputy Weiner responded to the location where this subject was suspected to reside.

During the course of their surveillance and subsequent investigation, the subject was discovered to reside at the target location within town. Furthermore, the deputies were able to locate and recover the merchandise stolen from the local business. The investigation also revealed that several other subjects were connected to this organized theft ring, and linked them to several open criminal investigations within the town.

Due to Deputy Weiner and Jacobson's investigative abilities, dedication to duty and teamwork, they were able to capture these criminals, putting an end to this recent rash of thefts. Their

continued exceptional performance highlights their dedication to the safety of the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:** These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A statistical summary listing COP activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.

- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of five (5) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Five (5) fugitive(s) were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) persons legally classified as sex offenders currently residing within Town limits. These offenders are routinely contacted by BSO to ensure their continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Corporal Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of three and a half (3.5) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of nineteen (19) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of thirty four (34) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Gary Brown is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant each year on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Tom Palmer is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure upgrades to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Board:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public

safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

**Jazz on the Circle:** The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor the “Jazz on the Circle”. This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Music by the Sea:** Athena’s-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:**

On June 3, 2011, LBTS deputies observed a subject on Ocean Drive drinking from an open container of alcohol, in violation of town ordinances. Deputies contacted the subject, and upon further investigation, discovered that the subject has escaped from a prison work release facility. the subject was arrested and remanded to the custody of the Florida Department of Corrections.

On June 9, 2011, an AMR ambulance was struck by another vehicle while staging on the side of the road. Minor injuries were sustained by all parties involved. Preliminary investigation of the crash reveals that AMR does not appear to be at fault.

On June 10, 2011, LBTS deputies conducted an undercover narcotics operation within the town. Two subjects were arrested and charged with Delivery of Cocaine. The vehicle used in the crime and US currency was confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture.

On June 17, 2011, LBTS deputies received a report of items stolen from the beach. A witness was able to provide the description of a suspicious individual seen near the stolen property. Deputies were able to identify the suspect through their investigation. The suspect was arrested,

and it was discovered that he was involved in several other thefts and burglaries throughout the beach corridor area. All stolen property was recovered and returned.




