SUBJECT TITLE: Presentation by Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (Broward MPO)

EXPLANATION: The Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (Broward MPO) is an agency responsible for transportation planning, intergovernmental coordination and transportation funding allocations in Broward County. The Broward MPO works with the public, planning organizations, government agencies, elected officials, and community groups to address transportation needs and develop transportation plans, such as the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). This presentation will provide a brief overview of the 2035 Transportation Long Range Plan, updates on a number of key transportation projects on-going in Broward County, such as South Florida East Coast Corridor Transit Analysis Study, the Central Broward Transit project, State Route 7, as well as projects being conducted on Broward and Oakland Boulevards. 


Regional Context



Regional Rail: Diesel Multiple Unit (DMU) Alternative




- Each car has its own power
