**PERSONNEL CHANGES:**

On December 17, 2011, Sergeant Thomas Palmer was transferred from the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District to BSO's Internal Affairs Division.

On December 20, 2011, Sergeant Tammy Measel was transferred into the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District, filling the vacancy created by Sergeant Palmer's departure.

**EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Detective Manuel Alvarez-Jacinto**

During the month of November 2011, Detective Alvarez-Jacinto received a report of a burglary to an occupied residence. The victims reported that while they slept, someone climbed in through an open window, and took their wallets. In addition, it appeared the suspect took their car keys and stole their car as well.

Detective Alvarez-Jacinto was able to recover forensic evidence and develop significant investigative leads. Armed with this information, he continued his investigation, which took him to several locations throughout the county. He conducted interviews with a multitude of investigative sources. Detective Alvarez-Jacinto's investigation culminated in the identification of the two suspects that perpetrated this crime, as well as the recovery of the stolen vehicle and wallets.

After the suspects were apprehended, he determined that they were involved in multiple additional crimes throughout the county. Both suspects have extensive criminal histories for violent offenses. Detective Alvarez-Jacinto coordinated additional investigations with several detectives from other jurisdictions, and as a result, the suspects were charged with many other crimes.

Due to Detective Alvarez-Jacinto's tenacity in conducting criminal investigations, along with his ability to coordinate a complex multi-jurisdictional investigation, he was able to capture these two burglary suspects, putting an end to their crime spree. Detective Alvarez-Jacinto's continued exceptional performance highlights his dedication to the safety of the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:** These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** **Elder Links:** This program offers referral services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and/or mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches participants to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Our annual Shred-A-Thon to reduce identity theft event is incorporated into this program. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A summary of COP statistical activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge

and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.

- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of seven (7) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Seven (7) fugitives were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.
- **Sexual Offender Tracking Program:** There is one (1) person legally classified as a sexual offender currently residing within Town limits. This offender is routinely contacted by BSO to ensure his continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Existing municipal ordinances prohibit additional persons classified as a sexual offender or sexual predator from residing within Town limits. Deputy Craig Bachan administers this program.
- **Segway Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of four (4) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of twenty (20) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of twenty-six (26) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is utilized at strategic points throughout the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is currently operational and has recently undergone infrastructure and software upgrades to expand and enhance coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information,

upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.

- **Electronic Message Board:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

**Jazz on the Square:** The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor "Jazz on the Square". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Music by the Sea:** Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**World Record Dive:** On December 3, 2011, LBTS was the site of a world scuba diving record attempt by Allen Sherrod. The successful achievement of the record drew significant media attraction and crowds to the beach area. LBTS district deputies were assigned to a directed patrol of the area to ensure the safety of participants and observers.

**Christmas-by-the-Sea Parade and Event:** The Chamber of Commerce and the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted the annual Christmas-by-the-Sea Parade & Event on Wednesday, December 7, 2011. The parade portion consisted of elected officials and other dignitaries, public safety providers, high school marching bands and several other participating groups. The Christmas tree lighting event took place at Anglin's Square, and included several live music acts and other performers. Four (4) off-duty BSO detail deputies were assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents. Additionally, ten (10) additional deputy sheriffs from other BSO commands were assigned to the event, to ensure the safety of participants and attendees. This mutual aid participation resulted in no additional cost to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

**Marie White's Annual "Santa is Coming to Town" Event:** The annual "Santa is Coming to Town" event took place on Saturday, December 10, 2011, at the Beach Pavilion. Children had the opportunity to take photographs with Santa Claus. LBTS district deputies were assigned to a directed patrol of this event, to ensure the safety of participants and attendees.

**BSO/LBTS Shred-A-Thon / Operation Medicine Cabinet:** The Broward Sheriff's Office and the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted a combined Shred-A-Thon / Operation Medicine Cabinet event on Saturday, December 10, 2011. The event was held at Town Hall. One hundred fifty-one (151) cars participated in the event, and a total of 9,640 pounds of documents were submitted for shredding. BSO deputies also collected 1,690 units of controlled substances / prescription narcotics, and 27,000 units of other medications.

**Winter Fest Boat Parade:** On December 10, 2011, the annual Winter Fest Boat Parade was held along the Intracoastal Waterway (ICW). Participants sail their vessels along the ICW, festooned with holiday decorations. This event requires the Commercial Boulevard drawbridge to be locked in the upright position for the duration of the event. Four (4) off-duty BSO detail deputies were assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Menorah Lighting Ceremony:** The Chabad of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea held its annual Menorah Lighting Ceremony on December 22, 2011, at the Beach Pavilion. The event included several public speakers and live music. LBTS district deputies were assigned to a directed patrol of this event, to ensure the safety of participants and attendees.

**New Year's Eve Celebration:** Several downtown area restaurants hosted their annual New Year's Eve Celebration on December 31, 2011 at Anglin Square. The event included live music and other festivities, which draws large crowds, requiring multiple street closures. Ten (10) off-duty BSO detail deputies were assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:**

On December 8, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to a Bel Air residence in regards to a fire. All occupants were safely evacuated. LBTS VFD responded and extinguished a small fire. The State Fire Marshal responded and is handling the fire investigation.

On December 16, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to the 200 Block of Commercial Boulevard in regards to an assault. A motorist tried to pass a man riding a skateboard, who was blocking the street. The man on the skateboard became enraged, and attempted to strike the occupants of the vehicle with the skateboard, causing significant damage to the vehicle. Deputies were able to identify the suspect, and apprehend him later that evening.

On December 18, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to a report of a fire at 5000 N. Ocean Boulevard. LBTS VFD successfully extinguished the fire, after battling it for approximately one hour. The incident caused significant traffic detours and delays. The State Fire Marshal responded and is handling the fire investigation.

On December 20, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to 4510 El Mar Drive after receiving a report that a bystander found a package in the surf, which contained a suspicious white powder. LBTS VFD and AMR responded to the scene, as a result of a potential HAZMAT situation. The Broward Sheriff's Office HAZMAT unit also responded to assist with the resolution of this incident. The incident caused significant traffic detours and delays. Additional BSO deputies

were brought in from other districts to assist with the major traffic delays and detours. The suspicious white powder was determined to be innocuous and removed by BSO Fire Rescue.

On December 29, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to 230 Marine Court in reference to an Aggravated Battery. Upon arrival, the investigation revealed that the victim's live-in boyfriend struck her multiple times in the face and abdomen area. Deputies discovered that the victim was pregnant. The suspect has an extensive criminal record for violent drug offenses. The suspect was arrested, and deputies made arrangements to ensure the welfare of the victim and her unborn child.




