**PERSONNEL CHANGES:**

There were no personnel changes for the month of April.

**EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Harry Joseph**

On April 18, 2012 Deputy Joseph was conducting traffic enforcement on Ocean Drive in an effort to keep the area safe for motorists and pedestrians. Deputy Joseph stopped a vehicle for several traffic violations he observed. During the traffic stop, Deputy Joseph's suspicions were aroused to the probability that the driver was transporting illicit narcotics. As a result of his continued investigation, he was able to seize a significant amount of methamphetamines.

Due to Deputy Joseph's proactive efforts to detect and identify crime within Lauderdale-by-the-Sea, he was able to apprehend a suspected illicit narcotics user and remove a significant amount of methamphetamines from the local streets. Deputy Joseph's continued exceptional performance highlights his dedication to the safety of the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:** These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches participants to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.

- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Our annual Shred-A-Thon to reduce identity theft event is incorporated into this program. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A summary of COP statistical activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of two (2) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Two (2) fugitives were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.
- **Sexual Offender Tracking Program:** There is one (1) person legally classified as a sexual offender currently residing within Town limits. This offender is routinely contacted by BSO to ensure his continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Existing municipal ordinances prohibit additional persons classified as a sexual offender or sexual predator from residing within Town limits. Deputy Craig Bachan administers this program.
- **Segway Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of one (1) hour this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.

- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of ten (10) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of twenty four (24) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed throughout the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system has recently undergone infrastructure and software upgrades to expand and enhance coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Board:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

**Jazz on the Square:** The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor "Jazz on the Square". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Music by the Sea:** Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other

festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Easter by the Sea:** The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted their annual Easter-by-the-Sea event at Jarvis Hall on April 7, 2012. This event consisted of an Easter Egg Hunt for all children in attendance, an Easter Bunny Bonnet Contest and the consumption of juice and cookies by participants and guests. BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea deputies were assigned to a directed patrol of the event to ensure the safety of pedestrians and attendees.

**Easter Sunrise Service:** The Community Presbyterian Church of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea hosted their Easter Sunrise Service at the Beach Pavilion on April 8, 2012. BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea deputies were assigned to a directed patrol of the event to ensure the safety of pedestrians and attendees.

**Air & Sea Show:** On April 28, 2012, the City of Fort Lauderdale hosted the 2012 Air & Sea Show. The show involved multiple acrobatic displays of military aviation and other capabilities. The event regularly draws large crowds, which disrupt the normal traffic flow patterns along the barrier islands, and creates a significant impact on local public safety providers. BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea deputies were assigned to an operational plan to ensure the safety of town visitors and the uninterrupted flow of traffic. No significant incidents relating to this event were reported.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:**

On April 1, 2012, while conducting a directed patrol of the location, LBTS deputies arrested a subject who had broken into a vacant hotel to smoke crack cocaine. Deputies recognized the suspect as a career criminal wanted by the Ft. Lauderdale Police Department. Additional joint investigation tied the suspect to multiple crimes in Ft. Lauderdale.

On April 4, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to a report of a stolen bicycle near the pier area. Subsequent investigation led to the identification of a suspect. Information was disseminated to all LBTS deputies. While off duty at a restaurant in Ft. Lauderdale, an LBTS deputy spotted and recognized the suspect. The suspect was taken into custody without incident. This suspect is also believed to be tied into the theft of several unsecured cell phones from the beach area.

On April 6, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to assist VFD on a residential fire. It appears that the homeowner fell asleep while smoking, and woke up to notice his blanket afire. The resident threw the blanket out the window, which landed on his scooter, subsequently setting it afire. It was later discovered that the scooter was reported stolen out of North Carolina. The resident sustained minor burns. The scooter was a total loss. This investigation is still ongoing.

On April 13, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to a report of a person in need of medical attention in the pool area of a condominium. Upon arrival, deputies noted the person deceased. Investigation revealed that the victim was conducting pool maintenance. It is unknown at this time if a reaction involving pool chemicals contributed to his death, or if it was simply health related. No foul play is suspected. VFD conducted an assessment to ensure the area was safe for additional persons. This investigation is ongoing.

On April 18, 2012, LBTS deputies received information from a confidential informant regarding the whereabouts of a known fugitive who was wanted for a robbery committed in Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Deputies were able to set up a controlled meeting between the confidential informant and the fugitive, who was taken into custody without incident.

On April 18, 2012, an LBTS deputy on patrol noticed the front window of a local Japanese restaurant smashed out. Investigation revealed that a suspect had entered the business through the broken window, and took \$3 from a tip jar. This incident is believed to be related to a string of burglaries to Asian restaurants across the county, by a suspect referred to as the "Takeout Bandit".

On April 25, 2012, BSO Criminal Investigations Division Homicide detectives concluded their ongoing investigation of the 2009 explosion at the Ocean Hyperbaric Chamber, culminating in the arrest of two employees on the charges of Manslaughter and Aggravated Manslaughter. This investigation has been turned over to the Broward County State Attorney's Office.

On April 26, 2012, LBTS detectives participated in a surveillance operation targeting a known group of burglary suspects active throughout the county's beach areas. Detectives in unmarked vehicles were following the suspects through LBTS, when the driver of the suspect vehicle apparently realized he was under surveillance, and rammed one of the surveillance vehicles. The suspects were stopped utilizing a precision vehicle immobilization technique. All suspects were taken into custody with minimal injuries. These suspects are believed to be involved with two residential burglaries in LBTS within the past few months. This investigation is still ongoing.


