Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Volunteer Fire Department

Overview

In the month of April 2012, the Volunteer Fire Department continued its focus on fire prevention for high-rises and commercial properties; this month, 29 multi-family structures and commercial properties received their annual fire inspections. One high rise safety education presentation was performed, and 2 more are scheduled for the month of May.

During the month of April, the VFD assisted the town with the Easter event and the Community Church with the sunrise services. The VFD dedicated a total of 113 hours of community service for these events.

Responses:

The Volunteer Fire Department responded to 33 fire rescue calls within the limits of our contract.

- Out of the 25 fire rescue calls, 14 were fire alarms, 2 accidents with injuries, 5 elevator rescue, 1 vehicle fire, 1 commercial structure fire, and 2 HAZMAT calls.
- 1 HAZMAT call was received referencing an investigation of spilled chemicals. The VFD units responded to this call. Upon arrival, units secured the area and requested HAZMAT units from Fort Lauderdale due to the type of chemicals. VFD units assisted HAZMAT units with the decontamination and logistical support. All units were cleared after the HAZMAT teams confirmed the chemicals were not a threat.
- 1 structure fire call was received referencing a commercial structure fire located at 6002 N. Ocean Blvd; the Sea watch Restaurant. VFD units responded to this call. Upon arrival light smoke was found in the structure, after investigation it was discovered that smoke was cause by a burning electrical outlet. No injuries were reported.
- The department received 75 emergency 911 medical calls for April 2012. The department was dispatched to 51 of those calls, of which 41 were cancelled by the Chief on Duty or Med12. The department assisted M12 on 10 of the medical calls.
- In an effort to reduce the number of unwarranted medical calls dispatched to the fire department, the VFD updated the run card protocol in the month of April; a reduction in the amount of medical calls dispatched to the fire department will greatly decrease.



Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Volunteer Fire Department

Training:

The Volunteer Fire Department has 31 regular in-town members and 22 associate out of town members for a total of 53 active members.

The fire department held 10 regular drills, 8 specialized training sessions, and 2 ocean rescue drill which consisted of the following:

- 238 Hrs – Fire fighter skills: High Rise Company Ops. & deployment, SCBA, and Engine Company Ops, Vehicle extrication.
- 42 Hrs – FLUSAR MVR Ops course
- 56 Hrs – CPR Refresher Course
- 40 Hrs- Building Construction for the fire service
- 22.5 Hrs - Ocean Rescue drill
- 152 Hrs – Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) – with Chief Molenda from FLFR

A total of 550.5 hours were spent in training for the month of April.

In closing, the fire department will continue to work with the Home Owners Association and businesses to continue our fire prevention and fire education programs, and assist the town civil organizations with hurricane preparedness. In addition, the Volunteer Fire Department will continue to improve and increase fire department members training, as required by ISO and newly established state training curriculums.



