Subject: Monthly Report to Commission – May 2012

PERSONNEL CHANGES:

On May 19, 2012, Clerical Specialist Bernadette Cadette was transferred into the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District, filling an existing clerical specialist vacancy.

EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Detective Manny Alvarez-Jacinto

During the month of May 2012, Detective Alvarez-Jacinto received information that patrol deputies had made an arrest after a subject was caught sleeping in a building under construction. Knowing that the suspect had an extensive criminal history, Detective Alvarez-Jacinto began to review evidence and conduct additional investigation. As a result of his tenacity, the suspect was implicated in several additional crimes, including several in surrounding jurisdictions.

Later that month, Detective Alvarez-Jacinto was notified that a neighboring agency was investigating a suspect who was believed to have stolen several pieces of jewelry from a residence. While assisting the neighboring agency, Detective Alvarez-Jacinto was again able to tie the suspect into several crimes throughout the entire region.

As a result of Detective Alvarez-Jacinto's successful assistance to our partner law enforcement agencies, he has strengthened the bonds of inter-agency cooperation throughout the entire region.

His dedication to the pursuit of criminals contributes to the success of the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District and embodies the highest standards of professional law enforcement.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches participants to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Our annual Shred-A-Thon to reduce identity theft event is incorporated into this program. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A summary of COP statistical activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of seven (7) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Seven (7) fugitives were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.

- **Sexual Offender Tracking Program:** There is one (1) person legally classified as a sexual offender currently residing within Town limits. This offender is routinely contacted by BSO to ensure his continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Existing municipal ordinances prohibit additional persons classified as a sexual offender or sexual predator from residing within Town limits. Deputy Craig Bachan administers this program.
- **Segway Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of one (1) hour this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of thirteen (13) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of twenty seven (27) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed throughout the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system has recently undergone infrastructure and software upgrades to expand and enhance coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Board:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public

safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

SPECIAL EVENTS: These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

Jazz on the Square: The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor “Jazz on the Square”. This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Music by the Sea: Athena’s-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Hurricane Seminar: On May 17, 2012, the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea Property Owners Association hosted their Hurricane Seminar at Jarvis Hall. A guest speaker from the BSO Office of Homeland Security provided detailed information in preparing for hurricane situations. Handouts and literature was also provided to all in attendance, in preparation of the hurricane season.

Memorial Day Beach Bash: The Aruba Beach Café sponsored its annual Memorial Day Beach Bash Event on May 28, 2012. The event festivities consisted of a food buffet, pig roast, live music, dancing and promotional giveaways. Three (3) off-duty BSO detail deputies were assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents. Additionally, three (3) deputies from other BSO divisions assisted with the event due to the large crowds. This mutual aid participation was at no additional cost to LBTS residents.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:

On May 1, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to a report of a stabbing at 4301 N Ocean Drive. Investigation revealed that the victim became embroiled in an argument with an unknown person inside a store. In order to avoid an escalation of the argument, the victim exited the store. The suspect apparently followed the victim outside, and stabbed him once in the lower

abdomen before fleeing the scene. The victim sustained a non-life threatening wound. This investigation is still ongoing.

On May 18, 2012, LBTS deputies received multiple reports from the friends and family of a despondent subject who sent them a message via Twitter stating, "*this will be my last tweet*". Deputies were able to track the victim down to a local residence on Bougainvillea Drive, and were able to take her into protective custody after she exhibited suicidal ideations.

On May 22, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to a report of an unresponsive person inside a vehicle on Poinciana Street. Deputies found a deceased 19 year old female inside the vehicle. No signs of violence were identified. Although no foul play is suspected, this incident remains classified as a suspicious death. This investigation is still active.

On May 25, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to a report of missing property from a hotel room on El Mar Drive. Investigation revealed that the suspect apparently entered the room while the victims were sleeping, and took electronics and cash. This incident is believed to be related to other similar incidents involving hotels along the Ocean Drive corridor throughout the region. This investigation is still active.

On May 25, 2012, as part of an ongoing narcotics trafficking investigation, LBTS deputies executed a search warrant on a location identified as a cocaine distribution point. One suspect was arrested and charged with distribution of narcotics and other related charges. US currency believed to be part of narcotics transactions was confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture.

On May 26, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to a report of a suspicious incident in the Bougainvillea Drive area. A caller advised that she just observed an unknown subject rolling her neighbor's motorcycle along the roadway. Deputies were able to locate the subject, who attempted to flee upon sweeping them. Deputies apprehended the suspect and determined that he was attempting to steal the motorcycle.

On May 26, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to the area of 3900 N Ocean Drive in reference to reports of a male subject acting erratically. Deputies located the subject walking along the roadway and pushing pedestrians, clad only in socks and underwear. Deputies took the subject into protective custody under the state's Baker Act.
