# Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Volunteer Fire Department

---

## Overview

In the month of June 2012, the Volunteer Fire Department continued its focus on fire prevention for high-rises and commercial properties; this month 13 multi-family structures and commercial properties received their annual fire inspections and 32 re-inspections.

During the month of June, The VFD worked on the planning and development of the 4<sup>th</sup> of July event under the guidance of Commissioner Vincent; we have been working in conjunction with town staff, public safety partners, and local business to provide a fun filled event for this event.

### Responses:

The Volunteer Fire Department responded to 31 fire rescue calls within the limits of our contract.

- Out of 31 fire rescue calls, 15 were fire alarms, 7 accidents with injuries, 1 structure fire, 1 utility fire, 2 drowning, and 3 other fire calls.
- 1 structure fire was received referencing a fire at 1541 S. Ocean Blvd. VFD units responded and upon arrival discovered a gas operated pressure cleaner had ignited while being refueled in front of an apartment. VFD units extinguished remaining fire and searched apartment for fire extension; apartment sustained heavy damage due to high heat and heavy smoke. Florida State Fire Marshal was dispatched to the scene for investigation with the assistance of "Amber" an accelerant detection K9 officer. No injuries were reported during this incident.
- 2 drowning calls were received referencing drowning. VFD ocean rescue units responded to these calls. Upon arrival units assisted the swimmers out of the water; no significant medical assistance was required for any of the victims. No injuries were reported during these calls.
- There were 68 emergency 911 medical calls for the month of June 2012. The department was dispatched to 15 of those calls, of which 12 were cancelled by the Chief on Duty or Med12. The department assisted M12 on 3 of the medical calls.

## Training:

The Volunteer Fire Department has 32 regular in-town members and 26 associate out of town members for a total of 58 active members.

The fire department held 8 regular drills, 7 specialized training sessions, and 1 ocean rescue drill which consisted of the following:

- 300.5 Hrs – Fire fighter skills: Water Supply, Hydrants, truck maintenance, and Engine Company Ops.
- 40 Hrs – FLUSAR VMR Technician
- 40 Hrs – FLUSAR Operations level Confined Space Rescue
- 8 Hrs – Municipal Liaison Class and RIA Class
- 36 Hrs - Ocean Rescue drills
- 200 Hrs – Red Cross Ocean Rescue Class and Refresher course
- 40 Hrs – FEMA( L-592) Public Information Officer

A total of 664.5 hours were spent in training for the month of June 2012.

In closing, the fire department will continue to work with the local businesses, town staff and public safety partners to plan and prepare for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July event. In addition, the Volunteer Fire Department will continue to improve and increase fire department members training, as required by ISO and newly established state training curriculums.



