# Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Volunteer Fire Department

---

## Overview

In the month of July 2012, the Volunteer Fire Department continued its focus on fire prevention for high-rises and commercial properties; this month 87 multi-family structures and commercial properties received their annual fire inspections and 32 re-inspections.

During the month of July, The VFD incurred 628 hrs for the organization and development of the very fun and successful 4<sup>th</sup> of July event under the guidance of Commissioner Vincent. The VFD would like to thank all town staff, business, residents and volunteers that helped make this event a fun filled family day for the residents and visitors of our town.

### **Responses:**

The Volunteer Fire Department responded to 21 fire rescue calls within the limits of our contract.

- Out of 21 fire rescue calls, 8 were fire alarms, 3 accidents with injuries, 1 brush fire, 2 utility fires, 1 mutual aid surf rescue, 3 elevator rescues, and 3 other fire calls.
- Mutual aid was provided for a surf rescue call referencing swimmers in distress in Pompano Beach. VFD ocean rescue units responded to provide watercraft support for Pompano Beach Ocean Rescue. No injuries were reported during this incident.
- The department received 75 emergency 911 medical calls for July 2012. The department was dispatched to 17 of those calls, of which 7 were cancelled by the Chief on Duty or Med12. The department assisted M12 on 10 of the medical calls.

## Training:

The Volunteer Fire Department has 32 regular in-town members and 27 associate out of town members for a total of 59 active members.

The fire department held 10 regular drills, and 1 ocean rescue drill which consisted of the following:

- 351 Hrs – Fire fighter skills: Water Supply, Hydrants, truck maintenance, and Engine Company Ops along with SOPs.
- 40 Hrs – Private Fire Protection Systems FFP1540
- 27 Hrs - Ocean Rescue drills

The VFD provided town staff with a FEMA 4 hour Rapid Impact Assessment (RIA) class which is required by the Broward Emergency Management division for all Broward County municipalities.

A total of 418 hours were spent in training for the month of July.

In closing, the Volunteer Fire Department will continue to improve and increase fire department members training, as required by ISO and newly established state training curriculums.



