PERSONNEL CHANGES:

On August 25, 2012, Deputy Guntis Treijs was transferred from the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District to the Youth Intervention & Enforcement Division.

On August 25, 2012, Sergeant Tammy Measel was transferred from the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District to the North Lauderdale District.

On August 25, 2012, Sergeant Carlos Carrillo was transferred into the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District from the Dania Beach District.

EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Michael Hencken

During the month of July 2012, Deputy Michael Hencken took the lead role in the BSO LBTS district's participation with the Town's inaugural BugFest-by-the-Sea spiny lobster mini-season event. Deputy Hencken assisted not only in planning the Town's participation in this event, but also in various presentations to the community and visitors regarding the various aspects of spiny lobster harvesting techniques and regulations.

In addition, Deputy Hencken assumed the lead role in the operational plan designed to protect our marine fisheries resources and ensure the general safety of participating divers. Deputy Hencken conducted over 100 marine fisheries inspections, and coordinated enforcement responses with the Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission.

As a result of Deputy Hencken's proactive efforts to present a positive image for not only the Broward Sheriff's Office, but also for the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea, he

was successful in contributing towards a safe and memorable event for our residents and guests. Deputy Hencken's continued exceptional performance highlights his dedication to the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches participants to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Our annual Shred-A-Thon to reduce identity theft event is incorporated into this program. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A summary of COP statistical activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.

- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of nine (9) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Nine (9) fugitives were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.
- **Sexual Offender Tracking Program:** There is one (1) person legally classified as a sexual offender currently residing within Town limits. This offender is routinely contacted by BSO to ensure his continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Existing municipal ordinances prohibit additional persons classified as a sexual offender or sexual predator from residing within Town limits. Deputy Craig Bachan administers this program.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of sixteen (16) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of twenty four (24) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The security camera system is strategically placed throughout the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The security camera system has recently undergone infrastructure and software upgrades to expand and enhance coverage. The security camera system is currently undergoing repairs to fix damaged sustained by a lightning strike.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Board:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

SPECIAL EVENTS: These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

Jazz on the Square: The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor "Jazz on the Square". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Music by the Sea: Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

National Night Out Against Crime: On August 7, 2011, the BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District and the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted the 29th Annual National Night Out Against Crime. The event took place at El Prado Park. Attendees observed and interacted with several displays, including a SWAT rescue vehicle, All-Terrain Vehicles, and a Marine Patrol vessel. T crime prevention and community relations liaison deputy was on-scene, educating attendees on crime prevention measures and providing them various informational brochures. Our Citizen Observer Patrol component was heavily represented, and utilized the event as a recruiting drive, which led to several new members joining the group. The Village Grille donated a variety of food and drinks for the attendees.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:

During the last several weeks of August, LBTS deputies participated in an operational plan designed to enhance the safety of students starting the school year. Deputies conducted additional patrols of school bus stop areas within LBTS, to include additional hours spent enforcing traffic laws and reminding residents of the importance of traffic safety. No incidents involving school children were reported during the course of the operation.

Throughout the month of August, a rash of thefts of items from unsecured vehicles took place throughout the south Silver Shores area. LBTS deputies conducted several undercover and surveillance operations throughout the area. A local resident was identified as the suspect and apprehended. Several of the stolen items were recovered from the suspect. This investigation is still ongoing.

On August 12, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to a report of a residential burglary on Seagrape Drive. Investigation revealed that the suspect had broken a window to gain access to the residence and stolen property from within. Detectives received information from a confidential informant identifying a suspect. Surveillance was conducted, which led to the arrest of both suspects. All stolen property was recovered.

On August 19, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to a report of a disturbance at a local restaurant. Investigation revealed that the suspect had attempted to fraudulently use a credit card to pay her bill. The suspect was found to be in possession of multiple fraudulent credit cards and identification cards. The suspect was also found to be in possession of a sea turtle hatchling.

On August 20, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to a report of a strong arm robbery in the Bel Air neighborhood. Investigation revealed that the victim was walking along the roadway with several other people when the suspect attempted to unsuccessfully snatch a gold chain from her neck. Deputies from neighboring districts and Aviation assisted with the search, but the suspect was not located. This incident is still under investigation and is believed to be related to multiple similar incidents that have occurred throughout the northern part of Broward County.

On August 31, 2012, LBTS deputies responded to a report of a stolen vehicle from a local restaurant. Investigation revealed that the victim pulled up to the valet area, when the suspect walked up to her and advised her that he would park her vehicle. The victim gave the suspect the vehicle, and he drove away. The victim later learned that the suspect was not an employee of the valet parking contractor.
