Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Volunteer Fire Department

Overview

During the month of August, 2012 the Volunteer Fire Department continued its focus on fire prevention for high-rise buildings and commercial properties. Over the past month 142 multi-family structures and commercial properties received their annual fire inspections with an additional 37 re-inspections conducted.

The VFD worked closely with Town Staff, BSO, AMR and Public Works to prepare for, and mitigate damage resulting from Tropical Storm Isaac. Through this collaborative effort we were able to offer the residents of the Town of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea preparatory assistance as well as prompt response. The VFD also conducted a boot drive to raise funds for the Red Cross, which will benefit victims affected by Hurricane Isaac in Louisiana.

Responses:

The Volunteer Fire Department responded to 32 fire rescue calls within the limits of our contract.

- Of the 32 fire rescue calls received, 16 were fire alarms, 3 accidents with injuries, 1 residential structure fire, 6 utility fires, 1 surf rescue, 1 elevator rescue, and 4 calls classified as “other fire”.
- 1 structure fire call was received referencing smoke in a room, VFD units responded, upon arrival crews were confronted with heavy smoke and flames. VFD crews were able to quickly extinguish the fire, and preserve the structure. No injuries were reported.
- 1 surf rescue call was received referencing swimmers in distress. VFD ocean rescue units responded to provide watercraft support for Pompano Beach Ocean Rescue. No injuries were reported during this incident.
- The department received 64 emergency 911 medical calls for August 2012. The department was dispatched to 9 of those calls, of which 2 were cancelled by the Chief on Duty or Med12. The department assisted M12 on 7 of the medical calls.

Training:

The Volunteer Fire Department has 30 regular in-town members and 25 associate out of town members for a total of 55 active members.

The fire department held 10 regular drills, and 2 ocean rescue drills which consisted of the following:

- 328 Hrs – Fire fighter skills: Standard Operating Guidelines, Engine Company Ops, First Responder skills, extrication, tools & water supply.
- 40 Hrs – Fire Service Course Design FFP2741
- 47 Hrs - Ocean Rescue drills
- 11 Hrs – Annual Fire Inspections

A total of 426 hours were spent in training for the month of August. In addition, Lieutenant Daniel Chavez and Lieutenant Joseph Shulman successfully received their State certified Officer I certification.

In closing, The Volunteer Fire Department will continue to improve and increase fire department members training, as required by ISO and newly established state training curriculums.



