PERSONNEL CHANGES:

No personnel transfer(s) this month.

EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Craig Jacobson

On September 8, 2010, Deputy Jacobson was dispatched to a burglary conveyance call. Although the suspects fled the area prior to his arrival, he was able to locate a witness who gave a description of the suspect. Based on the description, Deputy Jacobson realized that the suspects were likely the suspicious persons that he had made contact with earlier in the shift.

Deputy Jacobson immediately responded to the motel where he knew the subjects were staying. He set up surveillance of the area, and observed the suspects in possession of several items which he knew had been stolen from the vehicles they had broken into. In addition to arresting the suspects, Deputy Jacobson also tracked down several other victims who did not realize their vehicles were broken into and returned the recovered property to them.

Not only did Deputy Jacobson protect the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea from future crimes by these offenders, but his actions also embody the highest standards of professional law enforcement.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens who are in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Doug Brown handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Watch Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Watch Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, being aware of suspicious individuals, protecting passwords and using caution in revealing information. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizens on Patrol (COP) Program:** Sergeant Doug Brown continues to manage this program and hold monthly meetings. COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Doug Brown is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of six (6) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Eight (8) fugitives were apprehended and arrested.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) persons legally classified as sex offenders currently residing within Town limits. These offenders are routinely contacted by BSO to ensure their continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Deputy Charles Pickell administers this program.

- **Segway Human Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of one (1) hour this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of five (5) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of forty (40) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure maintenance to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Boards:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

SPECIAL EVENTS: These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

Jazz by the Square: The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor the "Jazz by the Square". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Music by the Sea: Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other

festivities. Two off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Annual Fish Fry: On October 26, 2010, The Chamber of Commerce hosted their annual "Fish Fry" event. The event took place at Anglin's Fishing Pier, between the hours of 5:00 PM and 9:00 PM, which included live entertainment, food and other festivities.

Arts and Craft Show: On October 30-31, 2010, The Chamber of Commerce hosted their annual "Arts & Crafts Show". The event took place in the Anglin's Square area, between the hours of 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Three off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Children's Halloween Party: On October 31, 2010, The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted their annual "Children's Halloween Party". The event took place at Jarvis Hall, between the hours of 6:00 pm and 9:00 PM, and included the handing out of candy, games, face painting and a costume parade.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS/ARRESTS:

On October 2, 2010, LBTS deputies received information that a suspect would be delivering cocaine to a location in the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Two suspects were arrested for Delivery of Cocaine and Possession of Cannabis. The vehicle used in the crime and US currency were confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture.

On October 5, 2010, LBTS deputies conducted an undercover operation for purchase of trafficking amounts of Percocet. One suspect arrested and charged accordingly.

On October 7, 2010, a three year old child was injured when playing on a gate at Municipal Park. AMR responded and treated the child accordingly. The child was not transported to the hospital, since the injury appeared minor.

On October 9, 2010, LBTS deputies received information that a suspect would be delivering illegally obtained prescription drugs to a location in the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The suspect was arrested for Delivery of a Controlled Substance (Oxycodone / Darvocet). The vehicle used in the crime and US currency were confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture.

On October 11, 2010, LBTS deputies took a report of a burglary to an occupied residence. The following day, deputies located and arrested the suspect. The day after, the victim was threatened by the suspect's family member, who told her not to testify against the suspect, or she would be injured. LBTS deputies arrested the family member for Witness Tampering.

On October 14, 2010, LBTS deputies assisted the LBTS VFD and BSO Hazmat in closing off the 1500 block to the 1900 block of Ocean Drive due to a leak caused by the rupture of a natural gas line by a road construction crew. Traffic was detoured and no significant traffic issues were reported.

On October 14, 2010, LBTS deputies executed a Search Warrant as part of an ongoing narcotics investigation, resulting in the arrest of two suspects and the seizure of crack cocaine. The vehicle used in the crime and US currency were confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture.

On October 15, 2010, an out of state visitor was the victim of an attempted purse snatching while exiting a local hotel. The suspect attempted to grab the purse, but was unsuccessful. LBTS deputies are conducting the follow-up investigation with the assistance of detectives from the BSO Criminal Investigations Division.

On October 18, 2010, LBTS deputies arrested a suspect for Occupied Residential Burglary. The suspect was soliciting area residences and attempted to enter a residence, believing that no one was inside.

October 21, 2010, LBTS deputies assisted Sea Ranch Lakes Police Department with a Counterfeit Check joint investigation involving organized crime. Two suspects were arrested linked to approximately ten other incidents throughout Broward County.
