Overview

In the month of October, 2010, two public safety announcements offered on Channel 78; one regarding our fire prevention program for smoke detectors, and the second dealing with a voluntary recall from the US Consumer Product Safety Commission. Please see attached email.

During October, we were in attendance to the monthly Broward County Fire Chief meeting and the monthly County Mutual Aid meeting. In which, the Volunteer fire department has solidified mutual aid agreements for aid and training with our neighboring cities fire departments.

The High Rise Fire Safety Program is completed. The Fire Department is working with the Fountain Head Condominium Association and other high rise condominium associations to implement this program. The High Rise Fire Safety Program will include a power point presentation about the department, high rise fire safety, evacuation procedures and building fire safety plan and concluding with a fire drill.

The fourth quarter employee of the month is Firefighter Cheryl Johnson. FF. Johnson is a town resident, single mother who has successfully completed her fire fighter 1 certification, and is currently working on her EMT training. When she is not too busy with home or school, she volunteers her time with the fire department and town events; i.e. July 4th and the latest Halloween event as Sparky. Firefighter Johnson personifies the quality of members that are proud to be a part of this fire department.

Responses:

The volunteer Fire Department responded to 28 fire rescue calls within the time limits of our contract.

- Out of 28 fire rescue calls, 1 call was a HAZMAT call at 1460 S. Ocean Blvd, which involved a cut 1 ½ natural gas line. HAZMAT teams from Fort Lauderdale Fire Department and Broward County Fire Rescue were requested to respond to mutual aid. During that call A1A was closed for approximately 2 hours.
- As per the Broward County Dispatch Run cards profile changes which were finished and placed in service during October; the volunteer fire department was dispatched to 46 out of 68 medical calls. The fire department command staff cancelled 27 of the 46 medical calls dispatched which show a 58.7% decrease in medical call response. Nineteen calls were assisted by the Volunteer Fire Department.

Training:

The Volunteer fire department has 37 regular in-town members and 23 Associates for a total of 60 active members.

- A 4 hour Driver Safety class was held in Jarvis Hall and instructed by Plantation Fire Department instructor Jim Clark.
- Five members of the Volunteer Fire Department attended an aerial ladder class of 40 hours at the Plantation Fire Dept.
- The Volunteer Fire Department continued the 40 hour First Responders medical training for continuing education.
- This month the Volunteer fire Department held 9 drills which consisted of multi-company operations, Aerial Apparatus operations, driver safety training, hose operations and incident command using specialized software.
- Lifeguard classes are set-up for November 15, 16 and 17 with an American Red Cross Instructor. This training will enhance the safety of our firefighters when faced with a rescue during beach patrol

In total, 587.5 hours were spent in October for training.

The volunteer fire department members assisted the town with the Halloween event, where Sparky, the fire dog was introduced to the community and was well received by the children and residents in attendance. Bags containing fire prevention information for the kids were distributed along with fire safety brochures to the adults as part of fire prevention month.

In closing, the fire department visited the Floranada Elementary School and gave a fire safety presentation to approximately 35 learning disabled children.

Frigidaire and Electrolux ICON Electric Smoothtop Cooktops and Slide-In Ranges Recalled Due to Fire Hazard

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, in cooperation with the firm named below, today announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately unless otherwise instructed. It is illegal to resell or attempt to resell a recalled consumer product.

Name of Product: Frigidaire and Electrolux ICON Smoothtop Electric Cooktops and Frigidaire Slide-in Ranges with rotary knobs and digital displays

Units: About 122,000

Manufacturer: Electrolux Home Products Inc., of Charlotte, N.C.

Hazard: Liquids can pool under the control knob and cause the surface heating element to turn on unexpectedly, heat to temperatures other than expected and then not turn off, posing a risk of fire and burn hazards to consumers.

Incidents/Injuries: Electrolux has received 70 reports of incidents, including three reports of fires that resulted in property damage. Three minor burn injuries were reported.

Description: This recall involves Frigidaire and Electrolux ICON smoothtop electric cooktops and Frigidaire slide-in ranges with rotary knobs and digital displays. Model and serial numbers for the slide-in ranges can be found inside the oven door on the left side of the unit or on the underside surface on cooktop models. 

