EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH:

Deputy Craig Jacobson, CCN 13257

On 04-28-10, at approximately 2337 hrs, Deputy Jacobson observed the window smashed out at 4658 N. Ocean Dr, Lauderdale by the Sea, FL and he immediately called for back-up and secured the business. Deputy Jacobson with the assistance of Deputy Arteaga immediately gathered evidence and spoke to witnesses. A suspect was soon identified and placed into custody shortly after. This suspect had the potential to become a major crime threat. Due to Deputy Jacobson's swift actions this criminal was apprehended, removed off the streets of Lauderdale by the Sea and further crimes prevented. Deputy Jacobson's actions demonstrate his drive, initiative and determination to provide positive results within the Town of Lauderdale by the Sea. Deputy Jacobson is an asset to the Sheriff's Office, the citizens of Lauderdale by the Sea, and his professionalism is appreciated amongst his co-workers.

PROGRAMS:

- **Elder Links:** This program offers services to elderly residents who are in need of either medical, mental health, meals on wheels etc. through a deputy referral program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** Sergeant Doug Brown is handling all residential and commercial security surveys.

- **The Warrant Narrative System:** District personnel attempted service of nine (9) active warrants. Nine arrests were made.
- **Citizens on Patrol (COP):** Sergeant Doug Brown continues to manage this program and holds monthly meetings. The COP volunteers are a tremendous help to the district. They alternate assisting in office duties or patrolling as an extra pair of eyes and ears in the district.
- **Neighborhood Crime Watch Program:** Sergeant Doug Brown is overseeing the NCWP and organizes and conducts routine seminars.
- **Segway-The Human Transporter:** Deputies continue to use the Segway within the Town. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of five (5) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) sex offenders currently still residing within the Town limits. Deputy Charles Pickell continues to monitor this program.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** The deputies on all shifts utilize the bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to mingle one on one with the citizens and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of thirty three (33) hours.
- **ATV Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach. Deputies used the ATV / POLARIS for a total of eighty two and a half (82.5) hours.
- **Camera Surveillance System:** The camera system is being updated due to the recent relocation of the district office.
- **Cyber Visor:** Information initiative to encourage town residents to stay informed via email or text messages regarding town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important safety information.

ELECTRONIC MESSAGE BOARD:

The Broward Sheriff's Office continues to deploy the message board to various locations in the town to alert the citizens to any traffic problems, seatbelt enforcement and other important law enforcement issues.

SPECIAL EVENTS:

Jazz By The Square: The Chamber of Commerce and Village Grille sponsor "Jazz by the Square". This weekly event takes place on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music; food and beverages.

Music by the Sea: Athena's Restaurant on Saturday nights hosts their outdoor musical event which includes live music, food and other festivities.

Operation Medicine Cabinet 05/22/10:

The Broward Sheriff's office along with the Town of Lauderdale by the Sea hosted Operation medicine Cabinet at Jarvis hall. This was a prescription drug take back initiative.

Memorial Day Beach Bash 05/31/10:

Aruba hosted their annual Memorial Day Beach Bash. Live entertainment and food for local residents and tourists.
