SUBJECT TITLE: Resolution No. 2010-24 Amending Fire Rescue and Safety Service Fees

EXPLANATION: This item was discussed at the Town Commission meeting on April 27, 2010 and at the Commission Roundtable meeting of April 28, 2010. The Town Commission indicated favorably to create a new category for annual fire inspection fees for commercial structures under eight hundred (800) square foot. The revisions to the fee schedule are indicated on page six (6) of the Resolution, section (e) (1) (a). Staff added a new category for structures up to 800 sq. ft., reducing the required annual fee from one hundred and forty-four dollars (\$144.00) to seventy-five dollars (\$75.00). Attached is the amended Resolution.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Approval. The Town Fire Marshal agrees with this change.

RESOLUTION 2010-24

1 **A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF**
2 **LAUDERDALE-BY-THE-SEA, FLORIDA, AMENDING FIRE RESCUE**
3 **SAFETY SERVICE FEES BY ADDING A FEE CATEGORY FOR**
4 **INSPECTION OF EXISTING STRUCTURES OF LESS THAN 800**
5 **SQUARE FEET; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CONFLICTS, AND**
6 **AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

7
8 **WHEREAS**, Sections 8-2 and 30-53 of the Code of Ordinances provide that fire rescue
9 and fire safety services fees are to be set by resolution of the Town Commission; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the Town Commission previously adopted Resolution No. 2008-27, which
11 sets fire rescue and fire safety service fees; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2008-27 has been amended from time to time by the Town
13 Commission; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Town Commission has determined that an additional fee category should
15 be added to the aforesaid fees for existing structures which are less than 800 square feet.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF**
17 **THE TOWN OF LAUDERDALE BY THE SEA, FLORIDA, THAT:**

18 **Section 1.** **Recitals.** The foregoing “**Whereas**” clauses are hereby ratified and
19 confirmed by the Town Commission, and incorporated herein.

20 **Section 2.** **New Fee Category.** The Town Commission of the Town of Lauderdale-
21 By-The-Sea, Florida, hereby establishes an additional fee category for inspection of existing
22 structures which are less than 800 square feet, and hereby establishes a fee in the amount of
23 \$75.00 for the periodic/annual fire safety inspection, as set forth in the fire prevention and
24 protection services fee schedule attached hereto as Exhibit “A”.¹

25 Section 3. Severability. If any clause, section, or other part of this Resolution shall be
26 held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional
27 or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and in no way affecting the validity of the other
28 provisions of this Resolution.

29 Section 4. Conflict. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are
30 hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

31 Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon
32 its passage and adoption.

- a. The Town Commission finds that the fees and charges set forth in the fee schedule are reasonable and necessary in light of the services provided.
- b. Fire Prevention and Protection Service Fees. When application for a building permit or a fire safety permit is submitted for review, and prior to review and issuance of a permit, and inspection and testing, a fee for all elements of fire protection and life safety features shall be paid, based upon the following schedule. Other fees, as referenced throughout this schedule, are also applicable before, during, and after permit issuance.

4. Special Permit and License Fees (fees charged for a special permit or license do not include the costs for required pre-inspections, follow-up inspections, or standby firewatch-rescue services):

(a) Pre-inspection when required prior to issuance of a permit or license...\$160.00

(b) Follow-up inspections of permitted or licensed activities required for monitoring for code compliance... \$85.00

(c) Fees for standby firewatch and/or standby rescue services required as a condition of permitting or licensing shall be as specified in this fee schedule, Special Fees section. Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Fire Rescue will determine the requirements for standby firewatch and/or standby rescue services.

(d) Special Permit Fees:

(1) Outdoor-indoor seasonal sales of legal sparklers and pyrotechnical items, per site... \$400.00

(2) Outdoor-indoor retail sales of legal sparklers and pyrotechnical items, per site (annual renewal required)... \$400.00

(e) Special Event Permit Fees for Outdoor Events (includes all carnivals, festivals, concerts, and similar outdoor assemblies):

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- (1) Events with up to a total of five (5) rides, games, or booths, inclusive, (standby firewatch by certified fire inspector may be required)... \$160.00
- (2) Events with a total of six (6) to ten (10) rides, games or booths, inclusive, (standby firewatch by a certified fire inspector may be required)...\$240.00
- (3) Events with a total of eleven (11) to fifteen (15) rides, games, or booths, inclusive, (standby firewatch by a certified fire inspector is required, standby rescue service may be required)... \$320.00
- (4) Events with a total of sixteen (16) to twenty (20) rides, games, or booths, inclusive, (standby firewatch by a certified fire inspector is required, standby rescue service may be required)... \$400.00
- (5) Events with a total exceeding twenty (20) rides, games, or booths, inclusive, (standby firewatch by a certified fire inspector is required, standby rescue service may be required)... \$480.00

However, notwithstanding the forgoing, Special Event Permit Fees for Town-sponsored Outdoor Events for services provided by the Volunteer Fire Department shall be \$50.00.

(g) Special Event Permit Fees for Indoor Events (includes all special events within the interior of a building, tent, air-supported or membrane structure, or canopy: i.e., circus, concert, festival and similar indoor events):

- (1) Events within above stated structures up to 5000 sq. ft. ... \$280.00
- (2) Events within above stated structures over 5000 square feet and up to 10,000 square feet... \$360.00
- (3) Events within above stated structures over 10,000 sq. ft. ...\$480.00
- (4) Standby firewatch by a certified fire inspector is required for all special events within the interior of a building, tent, air-supported and membrane structure Exception: events within interior of canopy.
- (5) Standby firewatch by a certified fire inspector may be required for events within the interior of a canopy.
- (6) Standby rescue service may be required for all above events.
- (7) Miscellaneous special events not classified above (standby firewatch and/or standby rescue service may be required)... \$160.00

(h) Renewal of Expired Permits.

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(1) A new permit may be issued within ninety (90) days of the last inspection, upon payment of fifty (50) percent of the original permit fee.

(2) A pre-permit inspection is required at an additional fee.

(i) Failure to obtain a permit and/or Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Fire Rescue, Fire Prevention Bureau approval for any construction, alteration, remodeling, renovation, modernization, special permit, special process, special event, wayside stand, fireworks display, hazardous materials, and other similar special permit or license activity, shall result in a fee equal to two times the original fee for any permit, process, event, or activity covered under this fee schedule.

5. Special Service Fees.

(a) Standby Firewatch Services Fee:

(1) Standby firewatch services when requested for special functions and events or required at the discretion of the Fire Prevention Bureau, in accordance with the "Florida Fire Prevention Code" and the Broward County Local Fire Code Amendments.

(2) Minimum fee, per each certified fire inspector or certified firefighter, per hour or fraction thereof, four (4) hour minimum fee may be required...\$65.00

(3) Standby firewatch services requiring the use of fire rescue apparatus. (Use of fire rescue apparatus may be required at the discretion of the Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Fire Rescue, Fire Prevention Bureau:

A. Minimum of two (2) fire rescue personnel, plus one (1) fire rescue apparatus.

B. Fee per fire rescue apparatus, per hour or fraction thereof...\$275.00

C. Four (4) hour minimum fee may be required.

D. Each additional fire rescue personnel, per hour or fraction thereof... \$75.00

(b) Overtime Inspection Fee: For any inspections requested or required to be performed before 8:00 a.m. and after 4:30 p.m., Monday--Friday, or any hour during a weekend or holiday, a special overtime fee will be charged for each inspector required for the inspection.

(1) Minimum fee, per inspector, per hour or fraction thereof...\$65.00

(2) Four (4) hour minimum fee may be required.

(c) Outside Consultant-Engineer or Special Inspector Fee Recovery in accordance with the "Florida Fire Prevention Code," whenever deemed necessary.

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(1) To ensure proper code compliance and/or the installation of fire protection service, and for special inspections required for hazardous material facilities and/or processes code compliance, Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Fire Rescue. Fire Prevention Bureau may require the services of an outside consultant-engineer or special inspector.

(2) The costs for such services, in addition to the normal inspection fee, shall be borne by the applicant or owners of the facility or property.

(d) Code Enforcement Hearing/Administrative Appeal Filing Fee... \$160.00

(e) Illegal Burn, Hazardous Material Incident, Technical Rescue Incident, Suspicious/Incendiary Fire or fire/life safety hazard Response Fee:

(1) Minimum fee per response, per fire rescue apparatus, first hour or fraction thereof ... \$275.00

(2) Each additional hour or fraction thereof, per fire rescue apparatus... \$325.00

(3) Minimum fee per response, per fire rescue personnel, per hour or fraction thereof ... \$75.00

(4) Four (4) hour minimum fee may be required.

(5) Additional costs for replacement of expendable items utilized for incident will be borne by the property owner or other responsible parties; a detailed list will be submitted for full cost recovery following the incident.

(f) Fire Investigation, Hazardous Material Incident Investigation, or Hazardous Condition-Complaint Investigation fees:

(1) Minimum fee per each fire investigator/ fire inspector per hour or fraction thereof... \$75.00

(2) Additional fee for each fire rescue apparatus required for assistance with incident investigation, per hour or fraction thereof... \$275.00

(3) Four (4) hour minimum fee may be required.

(g) Fee for Maximum ~~Occupant~~ Occupant Load Certificate Inspection (required or requested), per hour or fraction thereof ... \$160.00

6. Procedures for Payment of Fees, Permitting and Licensing.

(a) Payment of fees for all plans examination, new construction inspections and testing, re-inspection and retesting, and permits and/or licenses, shall be made in advance, prior to the providing of said services, the issuance or approval of any permits, licenses or certificates of occupancy.

(b) Payment of fees for special services, including standby firewatch service, standby rescue service, emergency medical services, etc., shall be made in advance based on a reasonable estimate of the required hours of service in accordance with established minimums. If the actual number of hours is more or less than estimated and paid for, adjustments shall be made to the nearest one-half (½) hour.

(c) Proper application for special permits-licenses, and special services, shall be submitted to Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Fire Rescue Fire Rescue, Fire Prevention Bureau , no later than fifteen (15) working days prior to the requested permit-license issue date or event date.

(d) Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Fire Rescue Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Fire Rescue Fire Rescue may refuse to provide special services, and/or refuse issuance of special permits-licenses, if the application or request for same is untimely, full payment has not been made in advance, or if said permits-licenses will interfere with regular or emergency operations.

(e) There shall be assessed a late payment fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per day, for each additional day that the fees remain unpaid after the payment due date.

(f) All fees rendered for services, made payable to the Town of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea.
