**Subject: Monthly Report to Commission – July 2010**

**PERSONNEL CHANGES:**

No personnel transfer(s) this month.

**EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Charles Pickell**

On July 1, 2010, Deputy Pickell was conducting surveillance throughout the town in hopes of apprehending an attempted murder suspect. The night before, BSO Criminal Investigations Division detectives responded to the district and provided information on a suspect who had savagely kidnapped and violently beaten and elderly victim in Lauderdale Lakes, leaving him to die. The suspect was believed to be hiding out in Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. CID detectives conducted surveillance throughout the night, but were unable to locate the suspect.

As a result of Deputy Pickells' tenacious determination for apprehending fugitives, he correctly deduced that this suspect would eventually visit areas within the town frequented by tourists and visitors. Upon Deputy Pickell recognizing a vehicle that fit the description of the one that the suspect was driving, he set up a surveillance post to further watch the vehicle. He determined that the man driving the vehicle was the wanted fugitive. He then quickly took the suspect into custody without incident.

As a result of Deputy Pickells' attention to detail, coupled with his relentless pursuit of criminals within the district, he quickly removed this dangerous and violent fugitive from the street of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea before he could victimize our residents.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:** These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens who are in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Doug Brown handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Watch Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Watch Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, being aware of suspicious individuals, protecting passwords and using caution in revealing information. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizens on Patrol (COP) Program:** Sergeant Doug Brown continues to manage this program and hold monthly meetings. COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Doug Brown is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of eight (8) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Eight fugitives were apprehended and arrested.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) persons legally classified as sex offenders currently residing within Town limits. These offenders are routinely contacted by BSO to ensure their continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Deputy Charles Pickell administers this program.

- **Segway Human Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of one and a half (1.5) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of sixteen (16) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of eighty (80) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program involves specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system undergoing upgrades due to the recent relocation of the district office.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Boards:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

**Jazz by the Square:** The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor "Jazz by the Square" every Saturday night. This weekly event takes place every Friday on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Music by the Sea:** Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event which includes live music, food and other festivities. This weekly event takes place every Saturday on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. Two off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Independence Day Celebration:** The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea and the Chamber of Commerce sponsored the annual Independence Day Celebration. The event included a Parade and a Fireworks Display. The BSO LBTS district handled public safety concerns related to general security and traffic control for the event. Operational plans were drawn up to address anticipated public safety concerns. Thirteen (13) deputy sheriffs and approximately eighteen (18) other BSO volunteers from other BSO commands participated to ensure the success of this event. This mutual aid participation was at no additional cost to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS/ARRESTS:**

On July 5, 2010, the BSO Bomb Squad responded to a call for service involving unexploded commercial grade fireworks mortar shells that had washed up on the beach. The Bomb Squad safely removed and disposed of the mortar shells without incident. Investigation revealed that the mortar shells were not part of the LBTS fireworks display, and likely originated from a different Independence Day event.

On July 20, 2010, BSO deputies responded to assist VFD Beach Rescue on a drowning call. It appears as if the victim fell off his kayak due to the heavy surf, and was subsequently caught in the undertow. The victim was pronounced deceased at the hospital, and BSO CID Homicide responded to conduct the death investigation. There does not appear to be foul play involved.

On July 21, 2010, the BSO Bomb Squad and BSO Haz-Mat responded to a call for service involving a military smoke marker/flare that had washed up on the beach. The device contained phosphorous, which is a combustible that reacts violently to oxygen. The Bomb Squad safely destroyed and disposed of the device on-scene without incident.

On July 24, 2010, deputies on foot patrol of the El Mar tourism corridor observed a subject fleeing from a hotel. The subject was detained and investigation revealed that the subject had just burglarized the hotel business office. The suspect has an extensive criminal history and is classified as a multi-state offender.
