**PERSONNEL CHANGES:**

No personnel transfer(s) this month.

**EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Louis Kattou & Deputy Gerry Arteaga**

On July 24, 2010, Deputy Kattou and Arteaga were conducting foot patrol of the El Mar tourism corridor. Tourism is extremely important to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea, and out-of-town visitors often attract a criminal element who attempt to prey on them.

During the area check of the LBTS Resort & Beach Club, Deputy Kattou and Arteaga observed a disturbance involving a subject who was attempting to flee. A witness advised them that the subject had just committed a burglary. Deputy Kattou and Arteaga immediately gave chase to the subject while coordinating a perimeter to contain and apprehend the subject.

Subsequently, the subject was taken into custody and it was learned that he is a multi-state offender with an extensive criminal history.

Not only did Deputy Kattou and Arteaga protect the residents, businesses and visitors of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea from this career offender, but their actions also embodies the highest standards of professional law enforcement.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:** These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens who are in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services.

- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Doug Brown handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Watch Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Watch Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, being aware of suspicious individuals, protecting passwords and using caution in revealing information. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizens on Patrol (COP) Program:** Sergeant Doug Brown continues to manage this program and hold monthly meetings. COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Doug Brown is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of eleven (11) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Eleven (11) fugitives were apprehended and arrested.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) persons legally classified as sex offenders currently residing within Town limits. These offenders are routinely contacted by BSO to ensure their continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Deputy Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Human Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of one (1) hour this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.

- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of nineteen (19) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of forty one and a half (41.5) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and will be undergoing infrastructure maintenance to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Boards:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

**Jazz by the Square:** The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor "Jazz by the Square" every Saturday night. This weekly event takes place every Friday on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Music by the Sea:** Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event which includes live music, food and other festivities. This weekly event takes place every Saturday on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. Two off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Hurricane Preparedness Seminar:** On July 18, 2010, the Chamber of Commerce and the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted the annual hurricane preparedness seminar at Jarvis Hall. Numerous guest speakers and representatives from the Town's public safety providers

presented important information as to evacuation procedures, available resources, and other hurricane preparedness issues.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS/ARRESTS:**

On August 3, 2010, LBTS deputies responded to a medical call. Haz-Mat was called out due to a strong chemical odor in the residence. Investigation revealed multiple narcotics in the residence. Investigation is pending.

On August 13, 2010, LBTS deputies received information that a subject with an extensive criminal record was seen in the area of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Deputies conducted a surveillance operation. The suspect was observed looking through windows and trying to steal items from the beach hotels. The subject has an extensive criminal past, including charges of murder and rape. Deputies worked with Maryland authorities to violate the terms of his Sex Offender status and have him extradited back to Maryland.

On August 18, 2010, LBTS deputies executed a search warrant at the residence of an identified narcotics dealer after receiving numerous complaints from area residents. Crack cocaine, marijuana and pharmaceutical drugs were recovered from the residence. The subject was subsequently arrested.

On August 27, 2010, LBTS deputies learned that the narcotics suspect had been released from jail on bond. A surveillance operation was set up and the suspect was again arrested after deputies observed him dealing narcotics. Crack cocaine was recovered from his person.
