PERSONNEL CHANGES:

No personnel transfer(s) this month.

EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Eric Weiner & Deputy Manny Alvarez

Deputy Weiner and Deputy Alvarez were recently selected to participate in a crime suppression program, with an emphasis on enforcement of narcotics laws and investigation of narcotics related offenses. They were chosen for this assignment as a result of their leadership, integrity and dedication to duty.

They immediately began working several investigations involving narcotics and other criminal activity. Within a few short months, the results of their investigations are impressive. They have logged a total of 51 arrests and executed two search warrants, yielding seizures of felony amounts of cocaine, marijuana and illegally possessed prescription pills. In addition, their participation was instrumental in solving several other criminal investigations, which resulted in the recovery of a substantial amount of stolen property.

Their tenacity, hard work, dedication, and team work in the apprehension of criminal offenders is exemplary. Their dedication to the pursuit of criminals contributes to the success of the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District and embodies the highest standards of professional law enforcement.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens who are in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Doug Brown handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Watch Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Watch Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, being aware of suspicious individuals, protecting passwords and using caution in revealing information. Sergeant Doug Brown oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizens on Patrol (COP) Program:** Sergeant Doug Brown continues to manage this program and hold monthly meetings. COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Doug Brown is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of six (6) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Six (6) fugitives were apprehended and arrested.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There are two (2) persons legally classified as sex offenders currently residing within Town limits. These offenders are routinely contacted by BSO to ensure their continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Deputy Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Human Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions

and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of five (5) hour this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.

- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of thirteen (13) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of fifty two (52) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure maintenance to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Boards:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

SPECIAL EVENTS: These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

Jazz by the Square: The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor "Jazz by the Square". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

Music by the Sea: Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive . This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS/ARRESTS:

On September 8, 2010, LBTS deputies received a call of a burglary to a vehicle that just occurred. Based on the suspect description, deputies responded to a local hotel. Deputies had previously contacted several suspicious subjects who were staying at that hotel. Deputies set up surveillance and observed the subjects return to the hotel with multiple stolen items. Suspects were arrested, and most of the victims were able to recover their property.

On September 13, 2010, LBTS deputies received a call of a suspicious 55-gallon drum that had washed up on the beach. Investigation revealed that the drum contained seawater and diesel fuel. Investigation revealed that the incident appeared to be non-criminal and was turned over to LBTS VFD and handled as a haz-mat incident.

On September 15, 2010, LBTS deputies responded to assist the LBTS VFD with traffic control during a fire at the Fountainhead Condominium. Traffic flow on Ocean Drive was restricted for several hours. No traffic related concerns were reported.

On September 17, 2010, LBTS deputies responded to a domestic disturbance. Investigation revealed that a female has stabbed a male in the chest with a large knife. The female suspect was arrested on scene. The male victim is expected to survive.

On September 19, 2010, LBTS deputies conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle driving without headlights. The driver of the vehicle fled on foot. A perimeter was established, but the suspect escaped. Subsequent investigation revealed the identity of the suspect. District deputies are in the process of obtaining an arrest warrant.

On September 26, 2010, an LBTS deputy on patrol observed several subjects breaking into vehicles. A perimeter was established and the suspects were arrested with the assistance of BSO K-9 and Aviation.
