

Questions and Answers for ITB 13-05-01: Manufacturing and Installation of Wayfinding Signs
June 19, 2013

Q. Section 12.0, Opening of Bids, states "The Bidder agrees to maintain the terms of the bid for 120 days from the date and time of bid opening." Does this mean that the successful bidder will have 120 days to complete this project? If so, what are the liquidated damages for this project?

A. Section 13.2 – The Work shall be commenced within 5 days after the issuance of the NTP, substantially completed within 30 days and finally completed within 45 days thereafter. The liquidated damages are estimated to be \$50 per day and may be subject to negotiation.

Q. Section 15.1, Insurance/Evidence of Insurance, states "The Bidder shall provide evidence of current insurance coverage together with submission of the bid." In other words, are we required to submit a Certificate of Insurance with our bid?

A. Yes

Q. Section 17.2, Licenses, Permits and Fees, states "The Bidder shall provide a copy of the following licenses: Sign Contractor." Is this Sign Contractor license required at the time of the bid opening? If so, is this Sign Contractor license from the Town of Lauderdale By-The-Sea, the State of Florida or the County of Broward? Any additional information regarding this section would be greatly appreciated.

A. If you are licensed from the State of Florida, that works, at the very least you must be licensed in Broward County.
