MARINE ART UNVEILING RESCHEDULED!

Due to severe weather, tonite's (March 6) marine sculpture unveiling on Commercial Boulevard has been rescheduled to Wednesday, March 12 from 5 to 7PM.

There will also be music and food, and many shops along the street will offer customer specials for the Town's first 'Boulevard Walk.' The entire event is from 5 to 7PM.

The artwork unveiling will take place in the business plaza just east of the Commercial Boulevard Bridge on the north side of the road, near Gold Coast Scuba, 259 Commercial Blvd., Lauderdale-By-The-Sea.

Three other marine sculptures (sea turtle, sting ray and parrot fish) already grace the other business plazas on Commercial between Sea Grape Drive and the Intracoastal Waterway Bridge, as well as the Town's new 18-foot coral reef entryway sculpture. Those artworks were unveiled in mid-December, when the Town's Commercial Boulevard Streetscape Project was completed. The Town spent \$4.5 million upgrading the street with wider sidewalks, palm trees and new public plazas on the ocean to make Commercial Boulevard and its downtown district a more pedestrian-friendly destination.

The latest marine art depicts a sea fan and several small squids.
