



Upcoming Town Commission Election on March 13th

The Town has an election on March 13 and the following seats are open:

Mayor

Commissioner (District 1, Seat 1)

Commissioner (District 2, Seat 2)

Commissioner (District 1, Seat 3)

Residents interested in running can pick up candidate packets in Town Hall, 4501 N. Ocean Drive.

The mayoral seat is held by **Mayor Scot Sasser**, who has publicly stated he is not seeking re-election to a final two-year term.

Seat 1 in District 1 is held by **Commissioner Elliot Sokolow**, who is eligible to seek a second 4-year commission term.

Seat 2 in District 2 is held by **Commissioner Chris Vincent**, who is term-limited and cannot seek a third 4-year commission term.

Seat 3 in District 1 is held by **Vice Mayor Mark Brown**, who has resigned effective Dec. 13th in order to run for Mayor. Candidates who choose to seek this Commission seat will **only serve** the remaining **two years** on Brown's 4-year term.

The 1-week qualifying period starts at noon on **Jan. 2** and ends at noon **Jan. 9th**.

Mayoral candidates can live anywhere in Town. District 1 candidates must live in the north part of Town. District 2 candidates must live in the south (see the map below).

Even though commissioners represent specific districts, they are elected by all the voters.
