### **NEIGHBORHOOD DRAINAGE PROJECT COMPLETED!**

The project is completed and the new neighborhood landscaping looks great!

New drainage and landscaping was installed in the Lauderdale-By-The-Sea neighborhood that includes Hibiscus Avenue, Allenwood Drive and Tropic Drive.

## Background

Residents on three streets - **Hibiscus Avenue, Allenwood Drive** and **Tropic Drive** - will see swale restoration, landscaping and drainage improvements.

The swale restoration will improve drainage in the area. The landscaping aspect of the project will help to significantly increase neighborhood beautification. The swale restoration is only the first phase of the drainage improvements. Larger pipes and other key drainage system structures are also being installed.

Foxtail, Pindo and Sylvester palm trees will be added to all three streets. This part of the project was funded with a \$30,000 **Neighborhood Improvement Program** grant the **Town Commission** awarded to the neighborhood in 2012.
