**PERSONNEL CHANGES:**

On July 2, 2011, Deputy Collette Barnwell was transferred to the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District, filling an existing vacancy created by a previous retirement.

On July 16, 2011, Clerical Specialist Nikki Sucarichi was promoted and transferred to the BSO Warrants Division. The district is in the process of recruiting and selecting qualified candidates to fill this position.

On July 23, 2011, Sergeant Gary Brown was transferred upon request to the Ft. Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport District.

On July 23, 2011, Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch was transferred to the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea District, filling the vacancy created by Sergeant Gary Brown's transfer.

**EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Charles Pickell CCN 5282**

On July 6, 2011, Deputy Pickell responded to a report of a stolen generator. The generator was a large, very expensive commercial model. Based on Deputy Pickell's investigation, he determined that the generator was equipped with a Lo-Jack theft recovery system. He also determined through his investigation that the suspects may be driving a Ford crew cab pickup truck. Deputy Pickell disseminated this information to other surrounding districts, and requested their assistance.

Shortly thereafter, Deputy Pickell received information that the stolen generator may be at a storage yard in a neighboring city. Deputy Pickell immediately sought additional resources, and began a surveillance operation. The stolen generator was located within the storage yard, along with other commercial equipment stolen throughout the county. In addition, both suspects were identified and subsequently arrested.

Due to Deputy Pickell's investigative abilities and dedication in seeing a case through to a successful conclusion, he was able to capture these criminals, putting an end to their illicit operation. Deputy Pickell's continued exceptional performance highlights his dedication to the safety of the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:** These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral program services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches residents to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A statistical summary listing COP activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Peter LaGana is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.

- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of six (6) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Six (6) fugitives were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.
- **Sex Offender Tracking Program:** There is one (1) person legally classified as sex offender currently residing within Town limits. This offender is routinely contacted by BSO to ensure his continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. The only other sex offender living within Town limits has moved to a different state. Existing municipal ordinances prohibit additional persons classified as a sex offender or predator from residing within Town limits. Corporal Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of two (2) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of twenty-two (22) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of forty three (43) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Gary Brown is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant each year on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Tom Palmer is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is strategically placed at points of entrance and exit to the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is up and running and is currently undergoing infrastructure upgrades to expand coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.

- **Electronic Message Board:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

**Jazz on the Circle:** The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor “Jazz on the Circle”. This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Music by the Sea:** Athena’s-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Independence Day Celebration:** On July 4<sup>th</sup>, the Town of Lauderdale-by-the Sea hosted its annual Independence Day Celebration. The event consisted of a parade, several activities for children, public safety displays and a fireworks show. The BSO LBTS district handled public safety concerns related to general security and traffic control for this event. Twenty-two (22) deputy sheriffs and approximately twenty-five (25) other BSO volunteers from other BSO commands participated to ensure the success of this event. This mutual aid participation was at no additional cost to LBTS residents.

**NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:**

On July 4, 2011, LBTS deputies, along with LBTS VFD and AMR, participated in the rescue of four juveniles who were drowning during the Independence Day Celebration event. The juveniles had swam out to a sandbar and were swept away by a strong current. Three of the four juveniles were rescued. The fourth juvenile was found floating in the water, unconscious. Immediate efforts were made to retrieve him and render emergency aid. Revival attempts were unsuccessful. This incident is classified as an Accidental Death.

On July 6, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to a business on Commercial Boulevard in reference to a report of the theft of a large commercial generator. With the assistance of a Lo-Jack device, the stolen generator was tracked to a storage facility at a neighboring city. BSO LBTS deputies set up a surveillance operation, and were able to arrest both suspects and recover the generator. Subsequent investigation revealed that these suspects were involved with multiple thefts and other crimes throughout the county.

On July 15, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to a hotel on N. Ocean Drive in regards to a burglary. A witness advised that the suspect was attempting to gain entry into a hotel room by prying open a window. The suspect fled the area. Deputies immediately began an area canvas, and located the suspect hiding at a nearby business. The suspect was arrested, and subsequent investigation revealed that he had committed another burglary earlier in the day.

On July 27-28, 2011, LBTS deputies conducted a joint wildlife regulation operation with Florida Wildlife Commission (FWC) agents. Uniformed and undercover deputies patrolled the LBTS beaches during the Florida Spiny Lobster mini-season, in order to ensure the safety of divers, and protection of the species.

On July 28, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to a residence on Marine Court in regards to a burglary. The victim advised that he had seen a suspect in his yard when he arrived at the residence. Upon entering the residence, the victim realized that his house had been ransacked, and jewelry and other items were missing. Deputies immediately began an area canvas, and located the suspect trying to flee the area. The suspect was arrested, and all property was recovered.




