ROADWAY STAMPING WORK COMPLETED!

The decorative asphalt ribbon stamping on Bougainville Drive is 100 percent complete!

This project was initiated to solve an acute neighborhood drainage problem, since Bougainville Drive was often heavily flooded after every extended rainstorm.

With the added landscaping and decorative ribbon stamping along the swale, Bougainville has become a much nicer roadway to live on and walk along.

The look of the street is expected to improve as the new trees grow and fill out.

The Town is committed to addressing drainage issues wherever they occur in Lauderdale-By-The-Sea. Other recent drainage projects include Bel Air in the north part of Town, and the HAT neighborhood (Hibiscus, Allenwood & Tropic) in the south.
