ALL PLAZAS TO BE OPEN ON TUESDAY!

This key downtown streetscape project is "substantially complete."

The east Beach Plaza is done and needs to be cleaned and sealed.

The western-most Dune Plaza installation should be complete by Saturday (12-21-13). It will then be cleaned and sealed as well.

The two final plazas should be open to the public by Tuesday.

Commercial and El Mar Boulevards are now completely open to vehicle traffic. Lights will be installed next week, and some tile work still remains to be done. The two plazas just east of the new water plaza should be done next week.

State Contracting and Engineering Corp., a Hollywood firm, is managing the project for the Town. State worked closely with Town staff to ensure that all substantial work was completed by the Dec. 3 deadline.

The project created wider, tree-shaded sidewalks, more room for sidewalk dining, unencumbered views to the Atlantic Ocean and dynamic public plazas. The Anglin's Square memorial bricks were also relocated to the beach pavilion.
