NEWLY-ELECTED TOWN COMMISSIONERS WILL BE SWORN IN ON TUESDAY, FEB. 14TH

Lauderdale-By-The-Sea's newly-elected Town commissioners will be sworn into office on **Feb. 14** at **7PM**, the next regularly-scheduled meeting.

The Town had discussed holding a special meeting on Feb. 6, but that meeting was cancelled.

Because the Town's election is being held on the same day as the **Republican Presidential Primary** (Tuesday, Jan. 31st), the **Broward Supervisor of Elections** needs at least 10 days to certify the results.

Three Commissioners will be sworn into office at the Feb. 14 **Town Commission** meeting, including **Mayor Roseann Minnet** and **Vice Mayor Stuart Dodd**, who were automatically re-elected when no one opposed them.

Town Commission candidates **Mark Brown** and **Edmund Malkoon** are running for Commission Seat 3. That seat was held by **Commissioner Birute Ann Clotney**, who did not seek re-election to a 4-year term.
