**Subject: Monthly Report to Commission – October 2011**

**PERSONNEL CHANGES:**

There were no personnel changes for the month of October.

**EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH: Deputy Harry Joseph**

Deputy Joseph handled a report of a stolen purse containing several high-value items from the beach. This report fit the *modus operandi* of several other recent thefts from our beach area. During his extensive canvas of the crime location, he was able to not only locate the stolen purse, but develop a suspect description from a witness who had seen the suspect in possession of the purse. Deputy Joseph then recognized the witness's description as fitting that of a local subject, who was known to him through several earlier suspicious person contacts. Deputy Joseph then began surveillance of the subject's residence. After making contact with the suspect and questioning him, Deputy Joseph was able to determine that the stolen property was located within the suspect's residence. After the suspect was arrested, all reports of items stolen from the beach area stopped altogether, putting an end to his crime spree.

In a second instance, Deputy Joseph was advised of the theft of a safe from a residence and given a description of the suspect. Deputy Joseph began to canvass the area, and located a subject matching the description. Again, after questioning the subject, he was able to determine that the stolen safe was located in the trunk of the suspect's vehicle. After the suspect was arrested, a significant quantity of illegal narcotics was also located and seized.

Both these instances illustrate Deputy Joseph's continued tenacity in conducting investigations and dedication to duty. Due to his investigative abilities and interview skills, he was able to successfully close out both of these investigations, and return all stolen property back to the victims. Deputy Joseph's continued exceptional performance highlights his dedication to the safety of the residents of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:** These ancillary programs and services are available to residents on an ongoing basis.

- **Elder Links:** This program offers referral services to elderly residents and other senior citizens in need of medical and/or mental health care, meal delivery or other social services. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Business and Residential Security Surveys:** The Business and Residential Security Survey Program teaches participants to secure their business, home or condominium to reduce the likelihood of burglary and theft. Sergeant Peter LaGana handles all business and residential security surveys.
- **Vacation House Watch Program:** Residents who are traveling out-of-town may register for this program. Deputies will conduct periodic checks of their residence until their return. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees the Vacation House Watch Program.
- **Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program:** The LBTS district Neighborhood Crime Prevention Program liaison organizes and conducts crime prevention and security seminars at the request of neighborhood civic and condominium associations. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program:** The Identity Theft and Scam Prevention Program is designed to inform residents about identity theft and how to lessen their chances of becoming a victim of a scam. Residents are informed on the importance of shredding documents, awareness of suspicious individuals, protection of passwords and use of caution in revealing information. Our annual Shred-A-Thon to reduce identity theft event is incorporated into this program. Sergeant Peter LaGana oversees this program.
- **Child Car Seat Installations / Inspections:** The Child Car Seat Installation program provides for education in the proper utilization of child safety seats. Deputy Jason Friedrich will install or inspect a child safety seat at the public's request.
- **Citizen Observer Patrol (COP) Program:** COP volunteers are local residents who receive public safety training. They are a tremendous asset to the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. COP members alternate assisting in administrative duties or patrolling local neighborhoods as an extra pair of eyes and ears to supplement deputy sheriff patrols. COP members also attend monthly patrol information and criminal intelligence briefings. Sergeant Peter LaGana manages this program. A summary of COP statistical activity is found at the end of this report.
- **Sheriff's Explorer Program:** The Sheriff's Explorer Program allows juveniles who are interested in pursuing careers in criminal justice a chance to enhance their knowledge and skill of law enforcement related topics through weekly training workshops. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district liaison for this program.
- **Fugitive Apprehension Program:** District personnel attempted service of six (6) active arrest warrants within the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. Six (6) fugitives were apprehended and arrested. Corporal Charles Pickell oversees this program.

- **Sexual Offender Tracking Program:** There is one (1) person legally classified as a sexual offender currently residing within Town limits. This offender is routinely contacted by BSO to ensure his continued compliance with State of Florida legal mandates. Existing municipal ordinances prohibit additional persons classified as a sexual offender or sexual predator from residing within Town limits. Corporal Charles Pickell administers this program.
- **Segway Transporter Patrol:** The Segway X2 provides for personalized service to specific areas of the community including parks, parking lots, community functions and special events. Deputies utilized the Segway a total of three (3) hours this month during both daylight and night time hours. This Segway was purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to the Town residents.
- **Bicycle Patrol:** Deputies on all shifts utilize patrol bicycles on a daily basis. This mode of patrol allows the deputies to interact one-on-one with our residents and tourists. The bicycles were utilized a total of forty-one (41) hours this month. These bicycles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **All Terrain Vehicle Patrol:** The ATV / Polaris is utilized primarily on the beach areas to provide residents with a beach patrol to deter criminal activity and to maintain the security of the beach-area properties. Deputies used the ATV / Polaris for a total of sixty three (63) hours this month. These All Terrain Vehicles were purchased utilizing drug money forfeitures at no cost to Town residents.
- **Crisis Intervention Team Program:** The Crisis Intervention Team Program encompasses specially trained patrol deputies and sergeants who are able to intervene in situations involving persons with mental illness or are otherwise experiencing mental health crises. Sergeant Edward Rafailovitch is the Crisis Intervention Team Program coordinator.
- **Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Patrol Program:** The BSO Marine Patrol Unit participates in the Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant on behalf of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea. The Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea currently receives in excess of 640 additional hours of Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant patrol hours each year. Sergeant Tom Palmer is the district liaison to the BSO Marine Patrol Unit.
- **Surveillance Camera System:** The surveillance camera system is utilized at strategic points throughout the Town in efforts to identify and deter criminal activity. The surveillance camera system is currently operational and has recently undergone infrastructure and software upgrades to expand and enhance coverage.
- **Cyber Visor:** This information initiative allows Town residents to stay informed, via email or text messages, of important Town topics such as criminal activity, traffic information, upcoming events, security issues and important public safety information. Residents can register for this program through either the Lauderdale-by-the-Sea or the Broward Sheriff's Office internet website.
- **Electronic Message Board:** The BSO Lauderdale-by-the-Sea district continues to utilize the electronic traffic safety message board at various locations within the Town. This allows us to alert residents about any traffic problems and other important public

safety issues. This electronic message board was purchased through grant funding at no direct cost to Town residents.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** These events required the participation of the BSO LBTS district.

**Jazz on the Square:** The Chamber of Commerce and The Village Grille sponsor "Jazz on the Square". This weekly event takes place every Friday night on Commercial Boulevard at El Mar Drive. Guests are entertained by live jazz music, food and beverages. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Music by the Sea:** Athena's-by-the-Sea hosts their outdoor musical event every Saturday night on Commercial Boulevard at Ocean Drive. This event includes live music, food and other festivities. Two (2) off-duty BSO detail deputies are assigned to work this event at no cost to Town residents.

**Beach Clean Up with Congressman Allen West:** On Saturday, October 1, 2011, the LBTS Chamber of Commerce hosted its monthly Beach Clean Up event. The event consisted of volunteers clearing the beach area of litter and other debris. Congressman Allen West participated in this event. BSO LBTS district personnel were utilized in providing security for the event.

**Town Hall Meeting:** On Tuesday, October 18, 2011, Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted a Town Hall meeting at Jarvis Hall with Congressman Allen West and County Commissioner Chip LaMarca. The meeting consisted of a question / answer forum with participation from residents and other members of our community. BSO LBTS district personnel were utilized in providing security for the event.

**Halloween Party:** On Monday, October 31, 2011, the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea hosted the annual Halloween Party at Jarvis Hall. The event consisted of a haunted house, host sponsored candy tables and costume contest. BSO LBTS district personnel were utilized in providing security and traffic control for the event.

## NOTABLE INCIDENTS / ARRESTS:

On October 2, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to a report from the VFD Beach Patrol of a suspicious package that had washed ashore. Investigation revealed that the package contained a large quantity of cannabis. LBTS deputies coordinated a response with the BSO Strategic Investigations Division, Aviation, Marine Patrol, and the U.S. Coast Guard. This investigation is still ongoing, and appears to be part of a large-scale maritime drug smuggling operation.

On October 14, 2011, LBTS deputies obtained information that a suspect would be delivering cocaine to a location within the Town. Surveillance was established and the suspect was identified. The suspect was arrested and charged with Delivery of Cocaine. The vehicle used in the crime and US currency was confiscated and submitted for civil forfeiture. After the suspect was released on bond, he made several threats to a witness in order to prevent him/her from testifying. The suspect was again tracked down and arrested by LBTS deputies on the charge of Witness Tampering.

On October 24, 2011, LBTS district deputies received information from the Hillsboro Police Department regarding a robbery that had occurred on State Road A1A within their municipality. Several deputies had previously dealt with the suspect on unrelated calls for service. Information received from several informants led deputies to the location of the suspect, who was attempting to evade capture. Surveillance was established, and the suspect was apprehended without incident.

On October 28, 2011, LBTS deputies participated in a joint operation with the Florida Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco (ABT) agents, geared towards the enforcement of juvenile alcohol restrictions for businesses. One arrest was made, relating to a local business that was unlawfully providing alcoholic beverages to minors. Florida ABT will follow-up on this operation through additional administrative sanctions towards offender businesses.

Throughout the month of October, LBTS experienced several vehicle burglaries that appeared to be related. On October 28, 2011, LBTS deputies responded to a vehicle burglary whereby the victim had confronted and struggled with the suspect. The suspect begged the victim to not call the police, as it was his birthday. As a result of this clue, deputies identified a potential suspect and made contact with him. The suspect was taken into custody after confessing to this crime and in the process of being charged with the other conveyance burglaries. No other vehicle burglaries have been reported since the arrest of this suspect.




