

# PLEASE DO NOT BRING YOUR DOGS TO EL PRADO PARK!



The Town of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea did **NOT** establish a dog beach at El Prado Park. The Town Commission initially passed an ordinance setting up a dog beach on a trial basis, but the proposed law was defeated 4-1 on second reading on July 22.

Unfortunately, the Hi-Riser and Sun-Sentinel published stories erroneously reporting that the dog beach had been approved. The proposal did receive initial approval on July 8, but all Town ordinances must be adopted twice before they can become law.

The Town requested a correction, which ran in the Sun-Sentinel on Wednesday, Aug. 6th. The Hi-Riser also said it planned to publish a follow-up article that would correct the original error.
