### BEACH WORKSHOP JAN. 25

The Town Commission has scheduled a special workshop for **Tuesday, Jan. 25th at 5 PM** in **Jarvis Hall** to discuss recreational uses on the Town's beach.



All Town residents, recreational users, business and property owners adjacent to the

beach are invited to attend this important workshop to discuss beach recreational uses and whether regulations are needed to protect public safety.

The recreational uses include surfing, fishing, boating, wind surfing and skim-boarding, etc.

### SEWER RATE HEARING JAN. 25

The Town Commission will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, Jan. 25 at 7 PM** in **Jarvis Hall** on proposed increases in the Town's sewer rates for residents who reside in the Sea Ranch building condos and south of Pine Avenue. The hike also affects all local businesses south of Pine.

The proposed sewer rate increase **does not affect residents in the north part of Town who receive their utility bills from the City of Pompano Beach.**

## Flood insurance savings on the way for LBTS homeowners

- Improved rating means a bigger premium discount for residents living in the Town's Special Flood Hazard Areas

**T**he **Town Commission** has some excellent financial news for homeowners who carry federally-backed flood insurance and live within Lauderdale-By-The-Sea's **Special Flood Hazard Areas**.

The Town's **Community Rating System** rating recently improved from **Class 8 to Class 7**, which will result in a **15 percent savings** for many homeowners. There are 1,400 flood insurance policies in effect in the **Town of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea**. The Town's Class 7 rating will generate **\$45,000** in flood premium savings for property owners. Residents in non-Special Flood Hazard Areas already receive a **5 percent** discount.

The **Federal Emergency Management Agency's** Community Rating System program offers incentives for **National Flood Insurance Program** communities that implement more stringent floodplain standards.

## Town reduces monthly solid waste pick-up rates for multi-family units

**A**fter extended negotiations with **Choice Environmental**, which provides us with solid waste service, the Town amended its contract with Choice to provide financial relief to multi-family units that use carts.

An ordinance adopted by the **Town Commission** in December changed the way multi-family units pay for service. Many multi-family units can now reduce their rates up to a maximum of 50 percent. Instead of requiring one cart per unit, properties have the option to reduce the number of carts used.

**Commissioner Scot Sasser**, who was appointed by the Commission to help re-negotiate the contract, said an 11-unit complex that only needed 4 carts would be able to reduce its current rates by 50 percent. There is also no charge if multi-family properties adjust the number of carts they use, as long as there are no more than two changes per year.

Sasser said about 90 of the multi-family properties in Town that utilize carts will immediately save money under the new fee structure.

After years with Waste Management, the Town signed a contract with Choice Environmental in 2009. The Town reduced fees for single-family homeowners by \$116 per year, but the bill for some multi-family properties increased. To address that, the Town renegotiated its contract with Choice.

No firm date has been selected for the trip, but **Vice Mayor Stuart Dodd** said May or July looks like the best possible months to visit. Henley's annual regatta is in June.

Henley, a beautiful riverside community in **Oxfordshire**, is world famous for its annual rowing regatta, which dates back to the early 1800s.

Situated about an hour

west of London, Henley-on-Thames is located on one of the most beautiful stretches of the **River Thames**, surrounded by wooded countryside.

The **Henley Regatta** was originally staged in 1839 by the Mayor and residents of Henley as a public attraction with a fair and other amusements. The emphasis of the event, however, quickly changed so that competitive amateur rowing is now its main purpose. □

## Two property tax exemption sign-up dates remain for Jarvis Hall

There are two special homeowner sign-up dates remaining this year in **Jarvis Hall** for **Lauderdale-By-The-Sea** residents who want to file for **Homestead, Senior** or any other property tax exemptions with the **Broward Property Appraiser**.

The sign-up meetings are in **Jarvis Hall, 4501 N. Ocean Drive** (next to Town Hall).

Deputy Property Appraisers will be in Jarvis Hall on **Feb. 7th** and **March 7th** from **11:30 AM to 1 PM**.

### WHAT TO BRING

The documents required to file a Homestead Exemption include all of the following:

— A current Florida drivers license or Florida identification card.

— A current voter registration card or declaration of domicile.

— The Social Security numbers of all owners.

**Please note:** Residents aliens must bring a permanent resident **Green Card**, proof of asylum or an **INS I-485** letter showing that your application to convert to permanent resident status is complete.

### ADDITIONAL EXEMPTIONS

**Widow/Widower:** Bring a copy of your spouse's death certificate, newspaper obit or memorial card.

**Disability/Veteran's Disability:** Contact the Property Appraiser's office about the filing requirements for these exemptions.

**Senior:** Requires at least one owner to be 65 or older as of **Jan. 1**, and your total household adjusted

gross income must not exceed \$25,780 (call **954-357-5579** for info on the required documents).

### Please note:

A husband or wife may file on behalf of both.

If you cannot make any of the remaining Jarvis Hall dates, the Property Appraiser's Office also has dates scheduled in other cities that may better fit your schedule.

The CRS rewards these efforts with discounts for residents on their flood insurance premiums.

The Town underwent a CRS audit in 2009. The Town's **Development Services** and **Municipal Services** departments, along with the **Broward County Building Department**, made several improvements that helped the Town achieve an improved Class 7 rating.

The Town received credit for posting more flood information on our Web site: [www.lbts-fl.gov](http://www.lbts-fl.gov).

In a recent letter to the Town, **Sandra Knight**, a FEMA insurance administrator, said the Town's efforts make it better able to withstand a disaster.

"I commend you on your community actions and your determination to lead your community to be more disaster resistant," Knight stated. "This commitment enhances public safety, property protection and protects the natural functions of floodplains, and reduces flood insurance premiums." □



