## TOP WEBCAM AWARD!

Our live beach camera received some national recognition in December after being selected as one of the 'Top 25 Most Interesting' webcams in the world. EarthCam's 20th annual list includes



some of the most unique webcams on the planet. We were selected from

among thousands of nominees worldwide. Winners were judged on image quality and uniqueness. The Town's beach cam is located atop the beach pavilion at the east end of Commercial Boulevard, overlooking the ocean and Anglin's Pier. ## New app offers another way to contact BSO

In addition to dialing 911, you can now alert the police using a smartphone app.

The **Broward Sheriff's Office SaferWatch app** allows smartphone users to contact police to report a crime or suspicious activity (*Please see flyer on Page 12*).

The mobile app was initially developed for students and school officials following the tragic Parkland shooting, but it is also being offered to the general public. The app allows users to send text, photos, video or audio tips about possible threats or crimes that have occurred. You can even make an anonymous tip using the app.



"SaferWatch is another tool for the public to provide law enforcement with timely information that can help us solve cases and ensure public safety," said **BSO Capt. Thomas Palmer**. "As the program expands, it will also allow BSO to issue real-time ALERTS to the subscribers in their given area. This application is available for download on your smartphone, it is simple to use, and it is free. Please remember this is **NOT** meant to replace a call to 911 if you are a witness or a victim of a crime in progress."

The SaferWatch App is available for every resident and visitor in Broward. If you submit a tip anywhere in Broward, even in a city that is not serviced by BSO, BSO will still take the information and forward it immediately to the proper police agency.

Tips submitted outside of Broward are handled by other law enforcement agencies.

## The Town's new website is more user-friendly

The Town's new government website makes it easier for residents and other visitors to quickly find the information they need.



The new site, which went live in December, has a search engine on the homepage where users can enter the basic information they are seeking. The new site is more visually appealing and includes a number of Town photos. The site is updated frequently and will be expanded soon to allow residents to sign-up for e-mail alerts about Town Commission and other important community news. ## Broward Property Appraiser offers help with Homestead Exemptions

The **Broward Property Appraiser's Office** will assist Town residents with filing **Homestead Exemptions** in **Town Hall** from **11AM to 2:30PM** on the following dates:

**Jan. 28, Feb. 25, March 25 and April 22nd.**



You must bring a Florida Drivers License or Florida identification card; Broward Voter Registration card or a Declaration of Domicile; and the Social Security numbers of all property owners.

Additional tax exemptions are also available for:

- **Widow/Widowers:** Bring a copy of your spouse's death certificate, newspaper obit or memorial card.
- **Disability/Veteran's Disability:** Ask the property appraiser's office about this exemption's requirements.
- **Senior/Low-Income:** This requires at least one owner to be 65 as of Jan. 1, 2019. Note: Either the husband or wife may file on behalf of both. Call for info on the required documents. For more info, call **954-357-5579** or visit **www.bcpa.net**.




