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
56 **SECTION 3. Severability.** If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance
57 is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding
58 shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

59 **SECTION 4. Conflicts.** All prior ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof in conflict
60 herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

61 **SECTION 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption on
62 second reading, and the new sewer rates shall be effective commencing the first day of the water
63 service billing cycle that begins in March 2020, provided that the City of Fort Lauderdale is able
64 to timely implement the changes; otherwise, the new sewer rates shall be effective commencing
65 the first day of the water service billing cycle that begins in April 2020.
