



## ANNUAL ARBOR DAY EVENT



## CELEBRATE LOBSTER MINI-SEASON!

BugFest is BACK! Join us in celebrating Florida's lobster mini-season during the 10th Anniversary of BugFest from July 26 through July 30, 2022. Divers, lobster lovers, and our LBTS community are invited to participate in the activities and events throughout the four-day celebration. We call it BugFest, Florida's biggest dive party!



Festivities include a Bug Hunting Seminar and Kickoff Party, the Great Florida Bug Hunt, the Lobster chef competition, a benefit concert supporting "Scuba 4 Good," a non-profit that teaches people with disabilities adaptive diving, and the Underwater Pier Cleanup at Anglin's Pier.

Did you know divers are allowed to bag up to 12 bugs per day and dive at night in Broward County? It's time to catch lobsters off your beach!



Deed fraud occurs when a property deed or title transfer is executed and recorded illegally without the authorization or knowledge of the true and present owner.

Criminals can record fraudulent deeds transferring ownership and then try to mortgage, sell, or rent your property.

Protect your property with Owner Alert, a free service that notifies you if a deed changing ownership of your property has been received by the Broward County Property Appraiser.



## BUSINESS TAX RECEIPTS QUESTIONS

If you are a new business here in LBTS, welcome to our Town! In order to be a legally permitted business, you must first obtain a business tax receipt. Below you will find some frequently asked questions concerning business tax receipts.

### Q. How do I start the process for obtaining a business tax receipt?

A. Your very first step is to obtain zoning eligibility. This is done through emailing our zoning team at [zoning@lbts-fl.gov](mailto:zoning@lbts-fl.gov), with the address and the intended use for the property. Once this has been established, our team will provide you with the correct application and instructions on how to submit the application.

### Q. If I want to rent my property on Airbnb, do I need a business tax receipt?

A. Absolutely! All rentals, even long-term rentals, require a business tax receipt license. Some properties are eligible for short-term licenses and others are eligible for vacation-rental licenses. Be sure to email our zoning team at [zoning@lbts-fl.gov](mailto:zoning@lbts-fl.gov), with the address to determine your eligibility before you list your property on any short-term rental or vacation rental site. Once zoning approves, you will need to obtain the appropriate certificate and complete inspections before you can begin to rent short-term or as a vacation rental.

### Q. Does the Town have an organization that connects LBTS businesses?

## BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT RENEWAL SEASON

Lauderdale-By-The-Sea businesses, it is that time of the year again! Our renewal season for the 2022-2023 fiscal year starts on July 1, 2022. In July, we will begin contacting each business via email to provide their renewal information. Payments are due before October 1, 2022. This year, our Town is offering three different methods for submitting payment. You can now pay online, through the mail, or by dropping off your payment in our new drop box. The box is located in the lobby of the building department for your convenience. So, keep an eye out for your notice of renewal and payment instructions in your email.


