

OCEAN RESCUE READY!

Since 2008, the Town's Volunteer Fire Department (VFD) has also been managing the Ocean Rescue Program. Under the direction of Fire Chief Judson Hopping and Captain Mark Kane, the Ocean Rescue Program currently has twenty-five members that participate on a part-time rotating schedule with our Volunteer Fire Fighters. While on their VFD shift, they help with monitoring the beach and waters.

Some of the team are already lifeguards, and all are certified First Responders. The Ocean Rescue Team has three ATVs and two jet skis that are equipped with life-saving equipment to aid in rescues. The Ocean Rescue Team is also responsible for the development and maintenance of the Town's Life Ring Program, made up of 39 poles and rings prominently placed along our beach.

We appreciate all that our Volunteer Fire Fighters and Ocean Rescue Team do for our community every day to keep us safe, so thank you for all you do.

YOU MIGHT NEED A PERMIT FOR THAT!

You've been thinking about this project: a Tiki hut would look great in your backyard by the pool, or maybe it's time to replace that old fence or update your landscaping. You find the design you like, talk to your contractor, and you're ready to go. But then you wonder, **"Do I need a permit from the Town?"**

Always check with the Development Services Department at Town Hall before completing work on your home. Don't assume your project won't need a building permit.

For example:

- Removing or replacing landscaping elements (particularly trees) requires a Town permit to ensure the property complies with Town requirements. It also usually requires a review and tree removal license from Broward County.
- Removing and replacing a fence, or a portion of your fence, requires a permit.

Remember, we are here to help you navigate the permitting process and avoid project delays. Plus, you can now submit your permit application online. Visit the Town's website and click on the pink Adirondack chair on the homepage to access the Building Division webpage. There, you will find step-by-step instructions on how to complete the electronic permit application.

RELAX...AND LEARN SOMETHING NEW AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER

The Town operates a quaint Community Center at Jarvis Hall (4505 N. Ocean Drive) that delivers programming to all its residents five days a week. If you live in Lauderdale-By-The-Sea or you've been around town for a while, then chances are you have met Armilio Bien-Aime, the Director of the Community Center. Mr. Bien-Aime, through his organization Bien-Aime Inc., has partnered with the Town to provide a safe, healthy, and activity-filled environment for all who call Lauderdale-By-The-Sea home.

“We are truly a community. I've been here for over 30 years. There is something for everyone here.”

Participants have a variety of classes to choose from including yoga, Zumba, Beginners Spanish, Cricut Design Space, Art - Watercolor, Mahjong, Bridge, Ping Pong, Computer and Tech, Jewelry Making, Beginners Italian, Calligraphy, and Wood Burning. Many of the participants gather after class on the portico to eat together, catch up on life with friends, or wait to attend the next available class.

The Center is supported by volunteers who teach classes and assist with programming. LBTS resident Marilyn Carr is one of the many volunteers who commit their time and talent to the Community Center. Marilyn has lived in Lauderdale-By-The-Sea for over 30 years and teaches watercolor and drawing classes. Originally from Philadelphia, Marilyn recalled how she and her husband decided to move to LBTS. “My husband and I spent our honeymoon in Miami. Once we retired, we traveled to different parts of Florida and found that Lauderdale-By-The-Sea was the perfect spot.”

She describes the Community Center as a friendly place to come and learn. “This place gets people out of their comfort zone.” She says she is encouraged when her students begin to see progress in their artwork.

“For so many of them, it's their first time using watercolors. They often surprise themselves.”

When she is not teaching art classes at the Community Center, she is volunteering with the LBTS Garden Club.

“The Center is a safe place to grow, learn, and share. People truly care for each other here.”

This is how Pauline McGuinness Brooks describes the Community Center. She was born in Canada and lived in the British West Indies, where she first learned about yoga. She has been teaching for over 20 years, including at the Community Center, after moving to Lauderdale-By-The-Sea in 1978. Her classes focus on centering the mind, body, and spirit.

When asked what she would say to encourage others to volunteer, she said, “Volunteering is a journey, it's a lifestyle, and is lifelong. It can allow you to grow better as a person.”

ANGLIN'S PIER UPDATE

For as long as most people can remember, Anglin's Fishing Pier has been a part of the Lauderdale-By-The-Sea community. The pier has always been privately owned and was built by the Anglins, one of the Town's founding families. Over the years, the pier was first owned by the Anglin family, then by Everett Sorensen and Frank Myatt, and then finally owned by the Anglin Family Trust with a lease to Fisherman's Pier, Inc.

For 80-plus years, residents and visitors have come to fish from the 1,000-foot pier (one of the longest in the state) or simply stroll its length, enjoying the fresh breeze and beautiful views of the ocean. Over these several decades, the pier had not escaped being damaged by storms, but the private owners were always able to rebuild and make sure that this iconic structure was open for our town. Anglin's Fishing Pier is such an important part of the Town's history and that is why the November 2022 destruction caused by Hurricane Nicole has affected the community so greatly. Since the November storm, many people have expressed concern about the pier and what is being done to rebuild it.

Fisherman's Pier, Inc. has been working diligently to assess the damage and determine what is needed to fix the pier. They have hired engineers, project managers, and an environmental consulting firm to help them navigate the bureaucratic process of getting the pier repaired or rebuilt. The Town is doing its part to ensure the safety of our residents in the pier's vicinity, and that the Fisherman's Pier, Inc. is moving swiftly toward making decisions regarding the pier's future.

To date, the Town has required Fisherman's Pier, Inc. to update the Town at two separate Special Magistrate meetings

(these meetings are held to ensure code violations are being addressed and if not, fines on the property can be assessed). At these meetings, the pier's representatives have given updates from the engineer regarding the safety of the structure. Timelines for providing safety inspections and progress reports were given at these meetings and thus far, have been met.

From this information, what we can currently state is that the section of the pier that is open to the public is safe for use. The remaining pier structure has been significantly damaged and may require reconstruction instead of repair. Engineers have been hired to start the state's environmental permitting process, which, unfortunately, can take up to two years to complete.

Town staff will continue to keep the community updated on the pier's progress. The Town has committed to doing what we can to expedite this process so that residents and guests can enjoy the pier as soon as possible.
