

DOWNTOWN ENHANCEMENT PROJECT IS MOVING FORWARD

Our town’s commitment to walkability is about to get even stronger. At the February 2, 2023, Town Commission meeting, the Commission approved Resolution 2023-08 to permanently expand outdoor seating and sidewalks in the downtown area as part of the Town’s Downtown Enhancement Project.

“In 2020, we temporarily expanded outdoor restaurant seating in our parking spaces to comply with CDC requirements during the COVID-19 pandemic,” said Mayor Chris Vincent. “Little did we know, we would receive so much ongoing support from the business community and residents to make these temporary

seating accommodations permanent. I’m excited to move forward with this project and enhance our downtown.”


The Enhancement Project includes a 4,050-square-foot sidewalk expansion, new lighting, signage, planters, and protective bollards. By expanding the sidewalks along Commercial Boulevard and Ocean Drive, we’re ensuring there are dedicated areas for outdoor dining

and walkways for pedestrians.

Whether you’re strolling through town, exploring by bike, or stopping by Ocean Plaza to soak in some Florida sun, we’re proud to be known as a “no car needed” community. This project will help prioritize the Town’s walkability for years to come while also providing more permanent outdoor dining options for residents and visitors to enjoy.



CIRCUIT IS COMING TO LAUDERDALE-BY-THE-SEA

At the March 16, 2023, Town Commission meeting, the Commission passed Resolution 2023-17, approving Circuit Transit Inc. to provide point-to-point transportation services in the Town. Circuit will replace the Pelican Hopper service previously available.



Electric Circuit Shuttles

Both residents and visitors will be able to request a Circuit shuttle to take them anywhere within Town limits. The service works similarly to popular ride-sharing companies. To request a ride, download the Circuit app, add your pick-up and drop-off points, the number of passengers, and enjoy a free ride through Town.

Circuit rides are on demand- no schedule is required! Using Circuit's 100% electric shuttles supports the Town's commitment to going green.

Service is estimated to begin in April 2023.

ANNUAL VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT (VFD) EASTER EGG HUNT

The hunt is on! The VFD will host its annual Easter Egg Hunt for residents on Saturday, April 8, 2023, at 9 a.m. at Friedt Family Park (4501 Bougainville Drive). 



THE 2023 SEA TURTLE SEASON IS UNDERWAY

It's sea turtle season in Broward County, and we're starting to see our oldest visitors come ashore. The season began on March 1 and will run through October 31. During this time, our beach plays an integral role in keeping these wonderful creatures alive by providing a place to nest. Once the eggs hatch, thousands of baby sea turtles will make their way down to the ocean.



LBTS residents, business owners, and visitors- please do your part to make this season a successful and safe one for the sea turtles:

1. Ensure all exterior lights are either turned off or shielded, and bulbs are switched out to amber or other sea turtle-friendly lighting.
2. Close drapes/blinds or turn off interior lighting at night to prevent lights from shining onto the beach.
3. Do not touch or disturb sea turtles, their nests, or the hatchlings.
4. Avoid using flashlights or flash photography while on the beach at night.
5. Remove trash and beach chairs, fill in any holes you may have dug, and knock down sandcastles at night.

VACATION AND SHORT TERM RENTAL TIPS FROM THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT

If you own a vacation or short term rental unit here in town, please remain mindful of the following rules:

Single-Family Residential Districts and Townhouses

1. Must have a vacation rental certificate and a business tax receipt. You can verify if a property is a legal vacation rental by accessing the rental map on the Town's website.
2. Guests must stay for at least seven consecutive days.
3. Occupancy is limited to no more than two people per bedroom, with total occupancy not to exceed ten people.
4. Occupants may only park in the spaces designated on the approved rental certificate sketch.

Duplexes, Multi-Family with Three or Four Units, Mixed-Use Buildings with One to Four Units (not a timeshare)

1. Must have a short-term rental certificate and a valid business tax receipt.
2. Can be rented to guests more than three times in a calendar year for periods of less than 30 days or one calendar month.
3. Occupancy is limited to no more than two people per bedroom, with total occupancy not to exceed ten people.
4. Occupants may only park in the spaces designated on the approved rental certificate sketch.
5. Pool and outdoor ground use is permitted from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Properties with More Than Four Units

The simple answer is talk to your homeowner's association. Properties of this type are only required to obtain a business tax receipt from Town. All other regulations are determined by the homeowner's association of your building. However, you can always check with the Development Services Department to determine if a unit in your building has a business tax receipt to rent.

Remember, our Development Services team is here to answer any questions you may have regarding vacation and short-term rentals. If an issue regarding a vacation or short-term rental arises in your neighborhood, please contact the Code Compliance Department at (954) 640-4210 or the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) non-emergency line at (954) 764-4357. By working together, we can keep Lauderdale-By-The-Sea the relaxing place that we love and enjoy.
