



CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN PROJECT UPDATE: CODRINGTON DRIVE

The Town is scheduled to complete the installation of the storm sewer system at Codrington Drive by the end of July. This project had a \$1.6 million budget for improvements.

Here is the latest status of the project:

- Completed pipe trench asphalt restoration
- Completed swale and sod restoration
- Stamped concrete driveways restoration
- Brick paver driveways restoration
- Completed final mill and overlay

BUSINESS TAX RECEIPTS QUESTIONS

If you are a new business here in LBTS, welcome to our Town! To be a legally permitted business, you must first obtain a business tax receipt. Below you will find some common questions with answers concerning business tax receipts.

Q. How do I start the process of obtaining a business tax receipt?

A. Your very first step is to obtain zoning eligibility. This is done by emailing our Zoning team at zoning@lbts-fl.gov with the address and the intended use for the property. Once this has been established, our team will provide you with the correct application and instructions for applying.

Q. If I want to rent my property on Airbnb, do I need a business tax receipt?

A. Absolutely! All rentals, even long-term rentals, require a business tax receipt license. Some properties are eligible for short-term licenses, and others are eligible for vacation-rental licenses. Be sure to email our Zoning team at zoning@lbts-fl.gov with the address to determine your eligibility before you list your property on any short-term rental or vacation rental site. Once approved, you will need to obtain the appropriate certificate and complete inspections before you can begin to rent your property short-term or as a vacation rental.

BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT RENEWAL SEASON

Lauderdale-By-The-Sea businesses, it is that time of the year again! Our renewal season for the 2023-2024 fiscal year starts July 1, 2023. In July, the Town will begin contacting each business via email to provide the business tax number and total amount due. Payments are due before October 1, 2023. The Town offers three payment options. You can pay online, via mail, or at Town Hall. So, keep an eye out for an email with your renewal and payment instructions.



IT'S BUDGET SEASON IN LBTS

The Town Commission and Town staff are working to develop the Town's Fiscal Year 2024 budget. Pre-budget meetings were held in May and June to prioritize the proposed enhanced services. The information gathered from these meetings will assist the Commission in determining programs that will be included in the proposed roll-back rate budget, the budget at the current millage, or another millage rate.

Although these meetings have already occurred, the community still has an opportunity to provide input and feedback on the Town's budget process.



Frequently Asked Questions

Is there a wheelchair-accessible shuttle?

Yes, to request an accessible shuttle, please select "yes" when prompted in the app if you need wheelchair access.

How many passengers can ride in one shuttle at a time?

Each shuttle can accommodate five passengers.

Can I bring my beach bag on board? Is there storage?

Absolutely! Each shuttle has a small trunk that you are welcome to place your belongings in.

Is my pet allowed to ride?

We love having your furry friends join us, but welcome them at the discretion of your driver and other passengers. If you do ride with your pet, they must remain on your lap or on the floor in between your feet for the duration of your ride.

Can I eat or drink while on board?

Eating and drinking, including alcoholic beverages, is not allowed while riding Circuit-By-The-Sea.

How can I get to Holy Cross Hospital?

Broward County provides a low-cost shuttle service, TOPSI, to eligible residents.

Does Circuit-By-The-Sea connect with Fort Lauderdale?

Yes! To connect with the City of Fort Lauderdale's LauderGo Circuit shuttle, schedule a ride to Galt Ocean Mile. Once there, your location will update in the Ride Circuit app and will allow you to book a ride with LauderGo.




PREPARE AND PROTECT: A REMINDER TO STAY PREPARED THIS HURRICANE SEASON

Hurricane season began June 1 and runs through November 30. To protect yourself and your loved ones, it's essential to stay prepared all season long. Hurricanes and tropical storms can bring destructive winds, heavy rains, and flooding, but with proper planning, you can minimize your risk.

- 1. Stay Informed:** Visit the Town's website (www.lbts-FL.gov) to sign up for CodeRED. CodeRED is the Town's emergency notification system used to distribute alerts via phone, e-mail, or text. Follow the Town's official Facebook, Twitter and Nextdoor pages for real-time updates during a storm. Lastly, visit noaa.gov for storm tracking information and pay attention to local news and weather forecasts.
- 2. Create an Emergency Kit:** Prepare a well-stocked emergency kit that includes essential supplies to sustain you and your family for at least seven days. It should include non-perishable food items, bottled water, flashlights, batteries, a first aid kit, medications, important documents, cash, and a battery-powered radio. Don't forget to include supplies for pets, such as food, water, and any necessary medications.
- 3. Develop an Evacuation Plan:** Create an evacuation plan that outlines escape routes, designated meeting points, and emergency contacts.
- 4. Secure Your Property:** Take proactive measures to safeguard your property before a storm is on the horizon. Trim trees and shrubs, secure loose outdoor items, and reinforce windows and doors with storm shutters or plywood (that is at least 5/8 inches thick) if you do not have hurricane impact windows. Clear gutters and drains to prevent water buildup. Consider investing in a generator for backup power. Review your insurance coverage to ensure it adequately protects your home and belongings.
- 5. Stay Connected and Supportive:** Maintain open lines of communication with your neighbors, friends, and family members during hurricane season. Aid those in need, especially the elderly or individuals with disabilities. Staying connected creates a strong support system and promotes resilience within our community.


