Celebrate the Fourth of July in Lauderdale-By-The-Sea

Lauderdale-By-The-Sea, Florida (June 17, 2022) – The Town of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea will hold its annual Fourth of July celebration on Monday, July 4, 2022, from 10 a.m. until 9 p.m., with a town parade, family-friendly activities at El Prado Park (4500 El Mar Drive), and a beachfront fireworks display.

“Our annual Fourth of July celebration is one of our most family-friendly events of the year,” said Mayor Chris Vincent. “From the town parade to our Family Fun Day, we have something for everyone to enjoy, regardless of age.”

The parade will feature the “Spirit of Liberty Fife and Drum Corps,” dressed in authentic costumes and marching to Americana music. The parade will travel south on Bougainvillea Drive, east along Pine Avenue, then south on El Mar Drive to Hibiscus Avenue. This year's parade Grand Marshal is Bob Karley, a “life-timer” in the Town, who was raised in Lauderdale-By-The-Sea and retired after being a part of the Town's Volunteer Fire Department for more than 17 years.

- 10 a.m. to 11 a.m.- Fourth of July Parade featuring the “Spirit of Liberty Fife and Drum Corps”
- 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.- Family Fun Day in El Prado Park with a giant waterslide, kid-favorite “Bubble Man,” a DJ, demonstrations from the Volunteer Fire Department, and more
- 9 p.m. to 9:20 p.m.- Fireworks display launched off the beach
