Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Accessible Highlights

Lauderdale-By-The-Sea has added many ADA compliant accessible features throughout the beach and other recreation areas for those with disabilities.

A Mobi Mat on the beach entrance allows those using wheelchairs, scooters, strollers, or walkers to go out onto the sand and come within varying distances of the water. **Pool Chair** lifts are available at many of the hotels in town to accommodate disabled guests.

Making it easier for everyone to enjoy the many eateries and shops throughout the Town, everything is just a stroll away. All the **sidewalks are ADA accessible** with ramps and the Visitor's Center is ADA accessible

In addition, many Town visitors utilize the Lauderdale-By-the-Sea [Pelican Hopper](#), a free and convenient way to get to a multitude of desired destinations around town if you are not walking. The air-conditioned shuttle transportation service is provided by the Town in conjunction with Broward County Transit. The service is free to residents and tourists and helps riders make connections to other Broward County Transit routes including the Public Bus as well as the Fort Lauderdale Sun Trolley. The **shuttle is wheelchair accessible** in accordance with ADA and comes equipped with a bike rack.
